## To register:

#### a) In Compuserve:

#### To install *Jump Color:*

By the time you read this file, you should have the program files in a special directory. If this isn't the case, then:

- 1) Create a new directory (e.g. c:\jumpcolr).
- 2) Copy these three files contained in the unzipped JMPCLR.ZIP to the new directory: jumpcolr.exe jumpcolr.hlp jumpcolr.wri

3) Move the fourth file, cmdialog.vbx, to your Windows System directory.

**4)** Make sure you have the file **vbrun300.dll** in your Windows System directory. If you don't have it, you can obtain this file from CompuServe (GO WINSHAR, LIB 1, 'VBRUN3.ZIP'). Please note that there are two currently known versions of this file. Make sure you're using the **vbrun300.dll** dated 4-28-93.

**5)** Create a Program Item in the Program Group of your choice using Program Manager. (Read your Windows manual for detailed instructions on this).
