

## Add-Ons to New Menus for Windows 1.1

The option **Context-Sensitiv** in the General Properties dialogue must be activ to use the add-ons

### Text-Edit

The Menu for Text-Edit-controls (entry `Edit` in the section `[WinClasses]`) appears, when the mousecursor is over a normal windows text-edit-control (f.e. Notepad or the 'File' of an File - Open dialogue).

- **Copy**: To copy the marked text in to the clipboard.
- **Insert**: Insert the text in the clipboard in the edit-control.
- **Cut**: To deletes the marked text and copy it in the clipboard
- **Undo**: To undo the last changes.
- **Search Text**:

**Search >**: To search the marked Text to the end of the text.

**< Search**: To search the marked Text to the beginning of the text.

If you press the **Shift**-key while selecting **Search >** or **< Search** the case is relevant.

- **Save**: To save the Text of the edit-control in a file.

### DOS-Box

The menu for **DOS-Boxes** (entry `tty` in the section `[WinClasses]`) appears if you push the right mousebutton over a DOS-Box (You can run DOS-Sessions in a window if you running Windows in enhanged mode).

- **Mark**: Switch a DOS-window from the Edit-Modus to the Mark-Modus. After using the menutiem **Mark**, you can mark text in the DOS-Box.
- **Copy**: To copy the marked region in to the clipboard.
- **Insert**: 'Insert' the text of the clipboard in to the DOS-Programm - or it is better to say, that the keys corrsponding to the text are send to the DOS-program.

### Scrollbars

- **Top**: To move the scrollbar to the beginning (up or left)
- **Bottom**: To move the scrollbar to the end (bottom or right)

### Listboxes:

- **Copy**: To copy the marked listitem in to the clipboard.
