

Text-Paint Documentation

Text-Paint is fairly straightforward. To make a painting simply click the "Assign Fonts" button on the tool bar. Type in the names of fonts you wish to use in each dialog. After that is done, click "OK", to keep the original font names, click "Cancel". To create text with which to make your brush, go to the Main window, and find the dialog the prompts you to add the text. It will say "Your comment here," Type in your text, or click on "Clipboard", and Text-Paint will paste in text from the clipboard. Note that Text-Paint will only paste in text(ASCII) from the clipboard. After you have created text for the brush, move the mouse over the picture window. The picture window is labeled "Painting in Text-Paint" When you have your painting completed, you may print it by clicking "Print" in the main window. To view information on Text-Paint, click on the "About" button. To quit Text-Paint, Click on "Quit".
