Carrier Pigeon Macro Installer Master Document

This document is really a template to carry macros.

DoubleClick the button above and you will be presented with a list box showing all of your Global macros. The ones you select will be attached to the document for transportation. You may choose to have the macros encrypted when copied to preserve your trade secrets.

To install as Global, just double click on the button below.

After picking up macro(s) to carry, you may change any part of the document except the part inside the bordered box above and it will still work. In this way you may create your own custom install document, and ship it around to your users. To save confusion, you should delete the macro "PickUpMacro" before you distribute it but you should not delete the macros "Install" or "AutoOpen". All the users have to do to install the macros as global macros on their machines is to double click the button in the bordered box.

Registered versions will incorporate the user name from "TOOLS OPTIONS INFO" in the confirmation box users see instead of the "UNREGISTERED" watermark message.
