How to use Doc Browser™

MegaWord Doc Browser is a handy utility that lets you quickly move to any part of your document. Doc Browser is fully wyswyg (What You See Is Where You Go), which makes it a lot more intuitive than Word's Edit GoTo command. You'll probably appreciate Doc Browser most if you want to find your way in a long document.

Installing Doc Browser

To install Doc Browser, copy this DOCBROWS.DOT file to the Startup subdirectory in your WinWord directory. Then start WinWord. The **Doc Browser** command will automatically be added to your **View** menu.

How to move to a page

Choose the Doc Browser command from the View menu. Then, in the Doc Browser dialog box:

- Select any page by clicking on the appropriate number in the Page Gauge.
- Choose the Start of Doc or End of Doc button to quickly move to the edges of your document.
- Click the Prev or Next button to jump to the previous or next occurrence of the selected item in the Go To list. Your options are: Page (default), Section, Annotation, Footnote, Endnote, Field, Table, Graphic, Equation, and Object.
- Choose the Close button to exit Doc Browser. The page you've last selected is immediately the
 active page

Notes

- Doc Browser works only when you're in Normal view or Page Layout view. In other words: not in Outline, Master Document, or Macro view. Doc Browser also refuses to work if the current document is empty.
- The Preview box doesn't show an exact representation of the selected page. Especially pages that have little text will look different in the Preview box.
- Doc Browser jumps on a page by page basis. If a page holds multiple instances of the selected Go
 To item (e.g. more than one field or section), choosing the **Prev** or **Next** button will jump to the
 previous or next occurrence of that item on a different page than the one shown in the Preview
 box.
- If the Preview doesn't display a new page when you choose a button, this means that there are no more occurrences of the selected Go To item in the document.
- If Doc Browser shows grayed out buttons, you can't jump in that direction.

Legalities

Doc Browser is Copyrighted material. You have the royalty-free right to use Doc Browser in any way you like. However, you are not allowed to publish or commercially use the Doc Browser code, or part of it, without written permission from the author.

Doc Browser is offered by Merlot International, the makers of MegaWord.

MegaWord is the the innovative WinWord™ Add-In that changes forever the way you work with your favorite wordprocessor. You can download the Shareware version of MegaWord from the MSWORD and WINSHARE forums on CompuServe; look out for the MWORD6.EXE and MWORD6.ZIP files. MegaWord is also available from other bulletin boards and through Shareware Distributors.
