

MACROS NOT ON THE KEYBOARD

Some macros in the FREE Keyboard library are not on the FREE Keyboard. They are in the library for various reasons.

- COUNT Counts the usage of a macro. See the macro for instructions on use. [Utility]
- BLOCKCPY | Simulates the Ctrl Insert and Ctrl Delete keys on enhanced keyboards
- BLOCKMOV | enhanced keyboards
- DIRNAME Names directories for long document displays. Not fully generalized for general use.
- HSPACE Replaces spaces with hard spaces for remainder of line. Used by rolodex macros to control sorting. John Smith, Esq. sorts on E as the last word while John Smith,[]Esq. sorts on S. [Rolodex Utility]
- ID A nice little trailer macro if you don't need the bells and whistles of the big one.
- L The original office macro. Please delete it, if it is still present. It is copyrighted by Ginsburg, Feldman and Bress and not the type of thing you would want to use anyway.
- MERGEUCU Merge cleanup. A non-generalized macro to get around the problem that a merge replace can not replace with nothing and similar limitations.
- SAVEDIR Used to save an entire directory or tree from a network drive to the local C drive. Unnecessary if you are running Pathworks or another reliable network but very necessary if using Novelle or have an unskilled or non-user oriented systems manager. [Utility]
- SBR_ A collection of some of the subroutines used in the other macros. Collected here for budding macro writers.
