This font was designed to be able to type in all of the consonant/vowel/accent combinations using a single font set. It differs from HBR in that the vowel points and accents are shifted to the left, whereas in HBR all the accents and vowels are shifted to the right. You still have to type the accents in using the ALT-0 keys, but since there are less combinations, you may actually be able to memorize the numbers.

These Hebrew and Greek fonts are sold by Donald Reiher Computer Support, for the purpose of encouraging scholarly study of the Scriptures. The registration cost is \$25 for the set. If you use HBR0 or HBR1, don't forget to register them as THEY ARE COPYRIGHTED SHAREWARE ARE NOT FREEWARE!! It has taken 4 years (hundreds of man hours) and thousands of dollars of hardware and software to create these fonts. Technical non-Roman fonts such as this generally run \$300-\$500 per font, so this is a real bargain.

QOPH

Single vowels fit nicely under qoph. If there is a vowel/accent combination under a qoph use the combination for the narrow letter. If there are 2 accents and a vowel under a qoph, the leftmost accent will hit the stem of the qoph. (For typesetting for a published work, you can use my HBR0 and HBR1 fonts which provide near perfect alignment of every combination, and which also can compensate for the qoph.)

COMBINATIONS with VOWELS AND ACCENTS (for the brave!)

Enter the consonant first, the vowel/accents jumps to the left. The numbers are entered using by using the "Alt keypad" method. Make sure NUM LOCK is on. Hold down the ALT key while typing 0 (zero on the number keypad) plus the number listed. Then release the ALT key. Repeat the process for each number listed. The 2 or 3 values can be entered in any order, as they are all (near) zero width characters.
