To install, push the button below, or use Tools, Macro, Organizer to copy the macro to your Normal.dot template.

Install

Before Using, Copy The BMP Logo to your WINWORD\CLIPART Directory. Copy using File Manager or DOS, WWLOGO.BMP to your WINWORD\CLIPART directory, normally C:\WINWORD\CLIPART.

To use this macro, simply run it from the Tools, Macro, Run menu. You can also copy the toolbar that comes with this template to your copy of Word. You can then run the macro from the toolbar You can also add it to one of your menus using Tools, Customize above. **Copying the toolbar** can be done using Tools, Macro, Organizer: First, click on the Toolbars tab. In the left box, make sure that this template, Alarm(.doc) is showing, and in the right, make sure that the template,

NORMAL(.dot), is showing. In the Alarm Box, highlight the Alarm! toolbar. Then choose copy. *Macros can also be copied in the same manner*. Finally, click on Close at the bottom. Now start a new document, and choose View, Toolbars, and put an X in the check box in the toolbar labeled Alarm!. For more help, consult your manual.

To use, simply run WWAlarmer and follow the directions on screen. DO NOT run the WWAlarm macro, for it is the actual alarm mechanism. Choose Help for more, on-line help.
