Some tips ...

If you want to be efficient, look at these tips:

- Use the <u>right-button menu</u>.
- To put and remove the menu quickly, just double-click on the display!
- To move the ICCD window, you don't need to have the menu and the title bar displayed, just left-click on the display and drag the mouse, the program will follow your movment!

The right-button menu

The right-button menu allows you to perform most of the operation with just one click.



You can:

- Play a song or pause the current playing
- Stop the playing
- Move one track up or down
- If the track or the disc has no title, you can give one
- Put the program in the tray bar
- Quit the program.

Version history of ICCD

- ◆3.2. This version is Microsoft CD Audio Player compatible. If you have filled the Microsoft's program database, ICCD 3.2 is able to retreive information about a disk without user intervention. The ICCD DataBase will be automatically filled by the program. Tool tips for each button have been added. When the cursor stays over a button for a moment, a tip is displayed explaining the button's function. The bug of a lot of resources being depleted when you wanted to change the display color has been fixed. There's a new registration mode. Now you need to enter your name along with the code. (If you already registered the program, send me regular mail or email with the address you previously gave me and I will send you a new registration code. I need the exact address!) The volume control bar has been added to control the CD Player's volume. The no sound button has been added to turn off the CD Player's sound output. (This can be very useful when your boss comes in!) The bug of the window position not saving when using the x button on the application bar has been fixed. The bug that when you were using the scroll bar, you couldn't use the keys afterwards to control the CD's play has been fixed too. You can now have the right-button menu on a button. The Help menu in the English version has been fixed with a comprehensive English text. You can put the program in the Windows 95 tray bar to have more desktop space.
- ◆ 3.1b. Ergonomic bugs fixed. The Player can now be always on top. The position of the player is saved when quitting, so when you run it the next time it will be at the same position on your screen. Multi-language Dialog Boxes (English & French) were added. Control buttons are now disabled when there is no audio CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- ◆ 3.1a. This version fixes several bugs, like the grid display. The Grid is now colored like the other displays. The grid now accepts CDs with 25 tracks or more. The awful "No Disk" bug, which was making the program hang, is now fixed.
- ◆ 3.1. With this version you can change the colour of the main display. You can choose a 16 million color palette. You can quit the program with the right-click menu.
- ♦ 3.0a. You can play the music just by pressing the "P" key. Stop the music with the "S" key.

The Disk menu:

Play / Pause allows you to play or pause the current track

Stop stops the playing

Track up moves one track up

Track down moves one track down

Forward plays 5 seconds forward

Rew plays 5 seconds backwards

Eject ejects the CD

No repeat plays normally the Cd (stops at the end)

Repeat disk repeats all the disk

Repeat track repeats the current track

Random play plays randomly the disk

Disk title assigns a name to the disk

Track title assigns a name to each track of the disk

The Display menu:

Menu displays or not the menu (see the tips for more details)

Icons displays or not the icon bar

Display displays or not the display

Volume displays or not the volume bar and volume icon

Grid displays or not the grid for quick track access

Songs displays or not the songs list box

CD title displays the CD title or the current track title

Time information displays the time information about the CD or the current track

<u>E</u>lapsed if the Time information option is enabled, displays the elapsed time for the current track

Remaining if the Time information option is enabled, displays the remaining time for the current track **Erom start** if the Time information option is enabled, displays the time elapsed from the begining of the CD

To end if the Time information option is enabled, displays the time remaining to the end of the CD

Always on top allows the program to stay visible even if you are working on another window

Append in tray bar puts the program in the tray bar

The Special menu:

Program makes a program list of your songs

Options allows you to configure the program

Display color allows you to change the display color and to choose into a 16 millions color palette

The Help menu:

Contents makes you go to help ...

About ICCD displays information about the author

How to register displays information about <u>registrating the program</u> (if the program is not already registred) (Did you registered it Dude ?)

The display



The display is located in the center of the program and inform you about :

- The main information (title or time information. In this case, the track number is in the left of the display and the time is in the right)
- What is displayed : the title (of the album or of the track) or the time information
- The time information mode (elapsed, remaining, from start, to end) see menu
- The repeat mode (normal, repeat, repeat one, random)

This button allows you to play or pause the current CD track.

Stops the play of the disc and puts the current track to 1.

This button allows you to eject the CD.

This list box contains the different songs of your CD. If you want to listen to a particular song, just double click on it!

This scrollbar allows you to go in a particular point of the song. When you move the scrollbar cursor, the display will show you the exact time.	

With this scroll bar, you can change the CD volume.

This button makes you go to the previous track.

This button makes you go to the next track.
