What is Program Group Fixer

Program Group Fixer is a 16-bit program that maintains your Program Groups and Items. It will run on on any 386 or greater PC containing Windows 3.1x, Windows 95, or Windows NT 3.51. **YOU MUST HAVE ADMINISTRATOR PRIVILEGE TO MODIFY COMMON PROGRAM GROUPS UNDER WINDOWS NT.**

Command Line Options

- -scale This option will increase the form size for any resolution except 640 x 480. If you are using large fonts, it may not look correct.

Add Program Groups and Items

This screen allows you to select files and add them as Program Items to new or existing Program Groups.

- Make the ADD page active by either clicking on the Add tab or by pressing ALT-A.
- Click the [Select Files](#) button and select the files to be added as items.
- If selecting files from multiple directories, check [Append to List](#) and click [Select Files](#) button and select the files to be added as items again.
- Add a new Program Group or select an existing one from the [Program Groups](#) list.
- Uncheck the [Common](#) box to make the group private (Windows NT).
- Modify the Program Item [Description](#), [Command Line](#) and [Working Directory](#) .
- Click [Run Minimized](#).
- If the program is 16-bit, click [Separate Memory Space](#)(Windows NT).
- When all information is correct, click the [Add](#) button.

Select Files

This button allows you to navigate to the directory desired and select the files to be added as items.

Append to List

When checked, additional files will be added to the Program Item List, otherwise, the selected files will replace the Program Items shown in the list.

Program Groups

This list contains existing Program Groups. Either select one that exists from the list, or, enter a new Group Name.

Common

If it is checked, the Program Group will be created as a common group, otherwise, it will be private (Windows NT).

Description

This will be the icon label displaying the description of the Program Item.

Command Line

This is the actual command needed to execute the program.

Working Directory

This indicates the directory the program will first look for any necessary files needed to run.

Run Minimized

If checked, the program will run as an icon, otherwise, it will run normally.

Separate Memory Space

If it is checked, and the program is 16-bit, the program will run in its own memory area, otherwise, it will be run in a shared memory area (Windows NT).

Add

Clicking this button will create/show the Program Group and add the items to it.

- Uncheck the [Common](#) box to make the destination group private (Windows NT).
- Select Destination program group from the [Program Group](#) list.
- Select Program item(s) to be copied/moved from the [Program Item](#) List.
- When all information is correct, Click the [Copy/Move](#) button.

- Select the program group from the [Program Group](#) List.
- Uncheck the [Common](#) box to make the new group private (Windows NT).
- Edit the new name for the program group in the [Name](#) field.
- When all information is correct, Click the [Rename](#) button.

Name

This field is the New Program Group Name.

Rename

Starts the Rename operation.

Editing Program Item Information during Add and Edit

- Resize column width by dragging column heading divider line to the desired width.
- Select active field (dotted line border) by either mouse double click or pressing F2.
- When in edit mode, background is **yellow**, accept the modified information by pressing F2 or mouse clicking in another field.
- To cancel the edit, press ESC.

Program Item Movement Keys During Add/Edit

Movement (Cell border is dotted)

Key	Action
<CtrlPgDn>	Move the active cell to the bottom of the page(the column remains unchanged)
<CtrlDown>	Move focus to the cell at the bottom-right of the table
<Down>	Move focus to the next cell
<End>	Move focus to last cell
<Home>	Move the active cell to the first column
<CtrlHome>	Move the focus to the first cell in grid
<CtrlEnd>	Move the active cell to the last cell in grid
<Left>	Move the active cell left to previous cell
<PgDn>	Move the active cell to the page following the current page
<CtrlLeft>	Move the active cell left a page(one window width)
<CtrlRight>	Move the active cell right a page(one window width)
<PgUp>	Move the active cell to the previous page
<Right>	Move the active cell right to next cell
<F2>	Enter/Exit edit mode
<CtrlUp>	Move the active cell to the top cell
<CtrlPgUp>	Move the active cell to the top of the page (column remains unchanged)
<Up>	Move the active cell up to previous row
<Mouse Click>	Activates Cell
<Mouse double Click>	Activates Cell and puts in edit mode

Editing (cell background is yellow)

Key	Action
<Home>	Move to first character
<End>	Move to last character
<Left>	Move left one character
<Right>	Move right one character
<ESC>	Cancel field changes
<F2>	Toggles Enter/Exit edit mode
<Mouse Click>	Exit edit mode and move focus
