Logical OR (|)

Parentheses should be used when comparing dissimilar macro statements with the OR (|) command. For example, the statement {IF} {VAR 0}>2|{VAR 0}<0~ will work, but when the expressions contain different commands such as {IF}({VAR 0}>2)|({STATE}&4)~, the expressions on either side of the OR (|) operator should be enclosed in parentheses.
