With Block Protect

**Problem:**

What is the best way to change regular parallel columns to columns with block protect? If you just change the definition, WordPerfect puts on one Block Protect code at the top of the document and leaves the rest of the sections the same.

**Answer:**

A macro like the following would probably be the best way to accomplish this task:
