<u>SUBJECT:</u>	Merge - Using {QUIT} With {CALL} And	

{LABEL}

In an advanced merge using {CALL} and {LABEL}, when a {QUIT} command is encountered at the end of a label, the merge stops and the rest of the primary file and merge codes are placed on the screen. This is because the {QUIT} command in a merge stops the merge so users can save the file and remerge later. To alleviate the problem, users can change the {QUIT} commands to {GO}end~ and place a {LABEL}end~ at the very bottom of the file.
