FileClip 1.1

Simple FreeWare utility written in Borland C++. This program is a useful companion to David Stafford's Launch Utility. It is used for those time when an application expects a path or file name, and does not provide a file system browser. e.g. RUN from Program Manager or changing ICON for Program Manager Program Item.

Use the browser to select file. Double clicking on a file without wildcards will copy its name into the Clipboard. To copy a filename with wildcards to the Clipboard, use the COPY button. Check boxes are provided for copying only the Direct ory path, or for changing the back slashes "\" to forward slashes "\". This conversion is required for copying path names to a UNIX system.

Version 1.1, stays resident, i.e., when selecting COPY, it minimizes itself. To close FileClip, select CLOSE from the System Menu.
