The Sound Forge XP 4.0 Demo contains all features of the Sound Forge XP package with the following restrictions:

- 1. You cannot Save any changes to your sound files.
- 2. You cannot open files in Direct Mode.
- 3. You cannot use the Clipboard to Paste data into other applications.
- 4. You cannot Record new sound data.
- 5. The program will run for only 15 minutes per session.
- 6. Most of the tutorial sound files are not included (to keep the size down).

To really get a feel for the usability and features of Sound Forge XP, we highly recommend you take the time to browse the Help file. Especially the Keyboard and Menu Shortcuts.

Sonic Foundry's web site (www.sonicfoundry.com) contains all missing tutorial sound files if you would like to download them for evaluation purposes.

Uninstalling the Sound Forge XP Demo

When you have finished evaluating Sound Forge XP, you will probably want to Uninstall the program. This will free up any disk space used by the Demos.

The Sound Forge XP Demo can be uninstalled by using the Add/Remove Programs option in the Control Panel on Windows 95 and Windows NT 4.0. On all other platforms, an Uninstall icon is created in the Sound Forge XP Demo folder.
