## **Original Author's Notes**

In this Packit III file you should have found three files:

- 1 IBMKlone.bmap - this is a standard Macintosh screen font and must be installed in your system file using Apples Font/Da Mover.
- 2 IBMKI - this is the Laserwriter font. Simply place this file in your system folder.
- 3 This Read Me file.

IBMklone is a postscript font designed to display the IBM PC font on the Macintosh. The character encoding is the same as on the IBM PC and so the Keys assigned to various characters may be different than you normally use to access the characters in a Macintosh font. To find a particular character, simply use your KeyCaps da. If a file is imported from the IBM, the characters will display correctly without modification.

*Deal #1:*

This font is shareware. The version you have here is a patch to the existing Courier font in the LaserWriter. The font is very useful for people preparing documentation for IBM products. It contains the entire IBM character set including graphics characters and line characters. The price - if you find it useful is \$10.00

*Deal #2:*

For \$25.00 I will send you another version of the font which has the correct aspect ratio for IBM screen simulation. Also, a complete set of smooth screen fonts are included (9,10,12,14,18,24,28,36 points.)

*Deal #3:*

For \$50.00 I will send you everything in Deal #2 as well as the source file for use in Fontographer so that you can modify the font as required for your own application.
