#### Whose Turn Is It?

#### **How Do I Move A Piece?**

• Remember that only White pieces can move during White's turn, and only Black pieces can move when it's Black's turn.

 $\cdot$  Position the cursor over the piece you want to move.

- $\cdot$  Hold down the mouse button.
- Keeping the mouse button held down, drag the piece to where you want it to go.
- · As you drag the piece, you'll see a "shadow" of your

piece in the square under the cursor *if* it is legal for you to move to that square.

• When you've dragged the piece to where you want it to go, let go of the mouse button.

# Rules

•White wins by surrounding Loki on all four sides. •Black wins by getting Loki to a corner.

•The game is a draw *if*:

• The current side cannot move *or*:

· Twenty-five moves are made without capture.

#### Moves

· White moves first.

• All pieces move the same way Đ horizontally *or* vertically any number of squares, *without* bumping into or jumping over any other piece.

• No pawn may move into or through a corner or center square.

### Capturing

- · Pawns are captured by sandwiching.
- If a single move makes multiple sandwiches, then a capture happens for each sandwich.
- $\cdot$  The center and corner squares can serve as one side of a sandwich.
- $\cdot$  Only one pawn in a row can be sandwiched.
- · It's safe to move into a sandwich.
- $\cdot$  Loki can capture pawns just like any other pawn, but

Loki cannot be captured. Of course, when Loki is surrounded on all four sides, White wins. *Exception:* If Loki is next to the center square, it takes only three pawns to capture him.
