

Getting Started

If you are upgrading from 2.08 then you should back up your databases prior to installing upgrade. If you install to the new default directory then you will have to copy your old databases to the new install directory manually. The syntax should be something like "copy c:\userinfo\userinfo.* c:\program files\i.s. user information"

I.S. User Information can be installed in any directory you see fit.

You can have the user data base reside on any physical drive or network drive

You can have multiple administrators share the same data base

You can have multiple instances of I.S. User Information running concurrently

The first time you start I.S. User Information

You will use the default password USERINFO



Command Line Syntax

If you have multiple databases you wish to use you can automatically start which ever database you wish to use the syntax is :

"C:\USERINFO\USER INFORMATION.EXE DATABASE.MDB"

Through the use of this command line you can create multiple icons for different companies and have them all running at the same time in one windows session.

Make sure the "Start in directory" is set properly. This should be the directory where I.S. User Information is installed in.

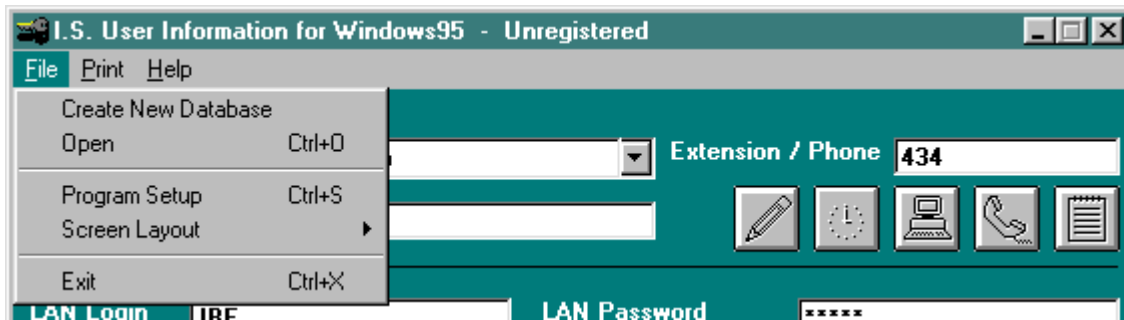

Create New Database

Creates new database and all associated files.
The file name MUST end in .MDB

Open (Ctrl-O)

Opens an existing database "*.MDB"

Program Setup (Ctrl-S)

Sets program parameters

Password - Password used to login (Default is USERINFO)

Default database - Should be a full file path i.e. "C:\USERINFO\MYDB.MDB"

Calls windows printer setup dialog box



User Name Field

Holds users full name.

Note:

For searching porpoises it is usually best to enter the name LASTNAME FIRSTNAME.

Type - *Text*
Length - *50*

Example:

Franklin Jason



Extension/Phone Field

Holds users extension or phone number.

Type - *Text*
Length - *30*

Example1:

434

Example2:

770-555-1234



Location Field

Holds users geographic location.

Note:

This field can also be useful for separating departments.

Type - *Text*
Length - *50*

Example1:

Atlanta, GA

Example2:

Atlanta, GA - Accounting Dept.



LAN Login Field

Holds users LAN Login ID.

Note:

Lot's of system administrators use the users initials for this field. The idea is it increases system security.

Type - *Text*
Length - *50*

Example1:

jason

Example2:

JBF



LAN Password Field

Holds users LAN Password.

Note:

This field will not be displayed unless you toggle the SHOW PASSWORD button, all you will see are "*****".

Type - *Text*
Length - *30*

Example1:

pass



NIC Address Field

Holds users NIC Address. (Network Interface Card Address)

Type - *Text*
Length - *30*

Example1:
608CE84A59



UNIX Login Field

Holds users UNIX Login ID.

Note:

Usually users sir name. And almost always lower case.

Type - *Text*
Length - *20*

Example1:

franklin



UNIX Password Field

Holds users UNIX Password.

Note:

This field will not be displayed unless you toggle the SHOW PASSWORD button, all you will see are "*****".

Type - *Text*
Length - *30*

Example1:

password



TCP/IP Field

Holds users TCP/IP Address. (Transmission Control Protocol / Internet Protocol)

Type - *Text*
Length - *40*

Example1:

192.231.189.6



TTY Field

Holds users TTY Address.

Type - *Text*
Length - *40*

Example1:

35

Port Field

Holds users physical Port Address.

Type - *Text*
Length - *50*

Example1:

26

Task Button

Clicking this to bring up a Task List, like a To Do list. Here you can cut and past to move certain jobs forward and backwards.

A must have for any system administrator.



Computer Button

Clicking this will display a screen linked to the current user where you can enter information about the users hardware.



Phone Button

Clicking this will toggle you between viewing/editing phone fields and normal display screen.



Note Button

Clicking this will toggle you between viewing/editing note fields and normal display screen.



Show Password Button

Clicking this will toggle you between viewing/scrambling password fields.



First Record Button

Clicking this move you to the first record in the database.



Last Record Button

Clicking this move you to the last record in the database.



Previous Record Button

Clicking this move you to the previous record in the database.



Next Record Button

Clicking this move you to the next record in the database.



Add Record Button

Clicking this add a record to the database.



Del Record Button

Click this to delete the current record from the database.



Quick View Button

Click this to view a spreadsheet like view of the current database.



Search Button

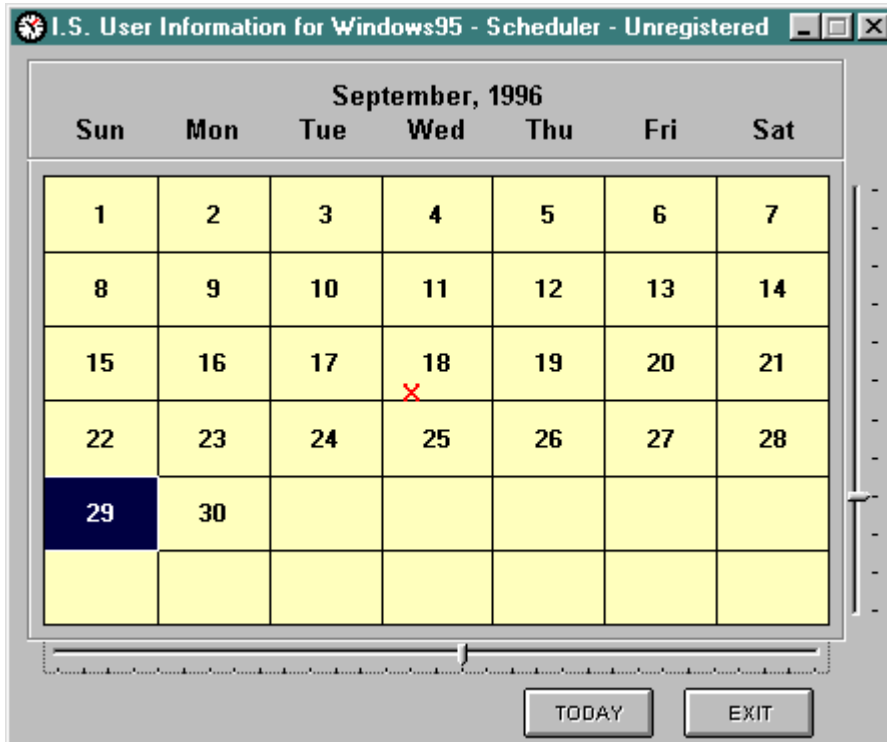
