Install the Software

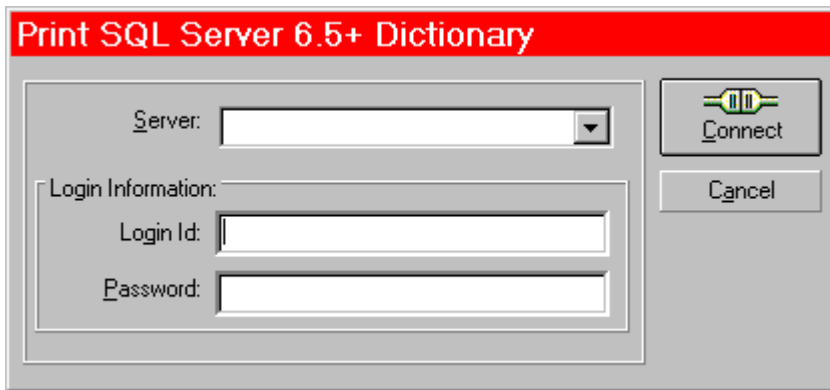
Install the software as described in [Install Software](#)

Starting SQL Server 6.5+ Print Dictionary

The installation process should have placed an entry in the *Start.Programs* menu. Select this entry or click on the SQLPrint.EXE. Before you start please refer to section [Running SQL Server 6.5+ Print Dictionary](#).

Connect to a SQL Server

The following dialog box is displayed when the Print SQL Server 6.5+ Dictionary application starts (or you can use the **File.Connect** menu option to display the dialog box)



Use this dialog box to connect to a SQL Server that has the database objects that you wish to print/preview. You must connect to the server before you can print/view objects.

- In the Server box, type the name of the server to connect to.
- In the Login Id box, type the server's login identification.
- In the Password box, type the password.
- Click the Connect button.

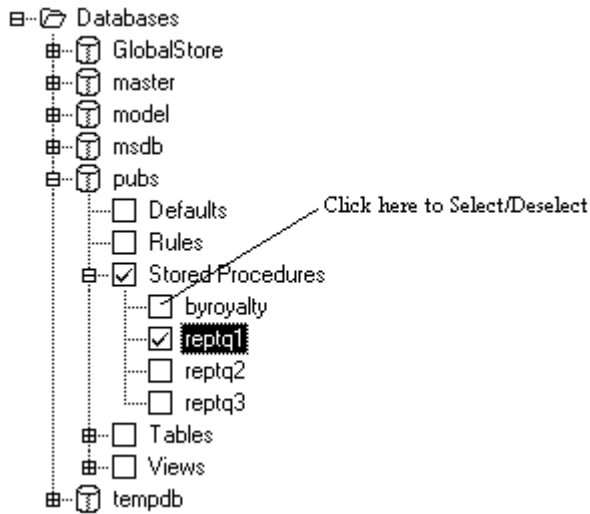
Select Objects to Preview/Print

Once a connection to a SQL Server has been established, the application displays all the databases using a tree view as shown below:




Click here to Expand/Collapse


You can expand and collapse the tree view branches using the NT Explorer like operations and select/deselect objects by clicking in as shown below:



Previewing Objects

Click the Preview button on the main application screen or select **File.Preview** menu command or click  on the toolbar. The application will start processing the objects and display the results in the preview window. You can cancel the operation by clicking on the Cancel button.

Printing Objects

Click the Print button on the main application screen or select **File.Print** menu command or click  on the toolbar. The application will start processing the objects and print the results. You will be given the opportunity to select the printer before printing starts. You can cancel the operation by clicking on the Cancel button.



Print SQL Server 6.5+ Dictionary allows you to produce professional looking reports for the SQL Server 6.5 object definitions (Tables, views, stored procedures, defaults etc.) You can select the objects and view the results in a preview window before printing. This product has been tested with SQL Server 6.5, however, it is possible [to connect to SQL Server 6.0.](#)

What is Provided with the Registered Version?

Multiple Object Selection

Allows you to select any number of objects from the list. You can also click on the parent node to select/deselect all objects.

No 'Nag' Screen

Does not display the 'Nag' screen.

No Watermark

The watermark 'Unregistered' is not printed.

Software Upgrades

Free software upgrades for 1 year from the date of registration.

Technical Support

Free technical support.

Connecting to SQL Server 6.0

This product has been tested using SQL Server 6.5, however, it is possible for it to connect to SQL Server 6.0. If you want to connect to a SQL Server 6.0 database then you will need to install the following script:

```
..\MSSQL\INSTALL\SQLOLE65.SQL
```

Make sure you are on the SQL Server 6.0 computer when you perform the installation operations.






Use ISQL or ISQL/W to execute the SQLOLE65.SQL script on the SQL Server 6.0 server. This installs the stored procedures necessary to support the SQL Server 6.5 DMO calls. It is better to install these procedures when no other access to the SQL Server is taking place. This script is also compatible with the SQL Server 6.0 DMO.

When the script installation is complete, check the results for errors.

Preview Window Commands

The following bitmap shows the bottom left hand of the preview window. You can use these buttons to move around the pages of the report.




-  Moves to the beginning of the report
-  Moves to the end of the report
-  Moves to the previous page the report
-  Moves to the next page of the report
-  Use this control to zoom the preview window

Other Facilities

- When scrollbars are visible, the page may be dragged by the mouse pointer
- Double-clicking the page zooms from 100% to 'Fit' view and back again
- When double-clicking the page from any view other than 100%, the page zooms to the clicked location
- Right clicking the mouse pointer displays a popup menu with all toolbar actions
- The toolbar may be hidden by right clicking the mouse button and selecting 'Auto Hide'
- Moving the mouse over the hidden (collapsed) toolbar forces it temporarily visible
- The toolbar may be dragged and repositioned to the top or bottom of the preview window
- Clicking the button in the corner of the scrollbars scrolls the page to the bottom-right
- Pressing the Home key will scroll the page to the upper-left
- Pressing Ctrl+Home will jump to the first page of the document
- Pressing Ctrl+End will jump to the last page of the document
- Pressing PageUp, PageDown, or the arrow keys will scroll the page
- To jump to a page anywhere in the document, the page number may be typed, followed by 'Enter'
- Multi-page documents may be viewed in 'Two Page View'
- Pressing Ctrl+1 thru Ctrl+9 and Ctrl+F zooms the page respectively
- When two pages are viewed simultaneously, MetaDoc will scroll automatically if one is out of view
- The programmer may set a 'Slow Drag' option for page dragging
- Unless the programmer specifies different, the preview window size and settings are retained for the user

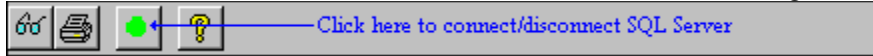

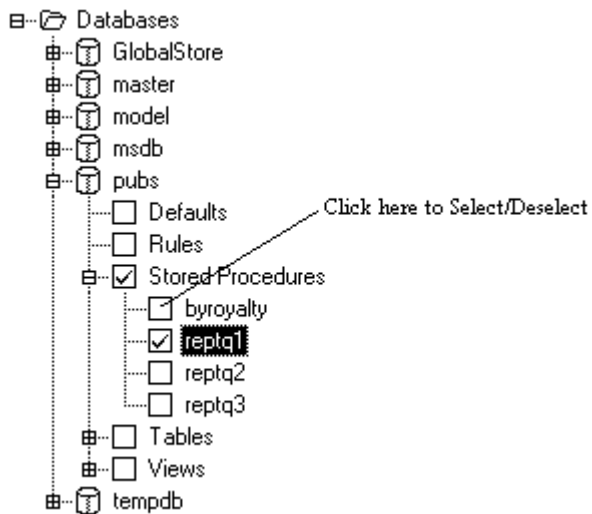
Re-connecting SQL Server

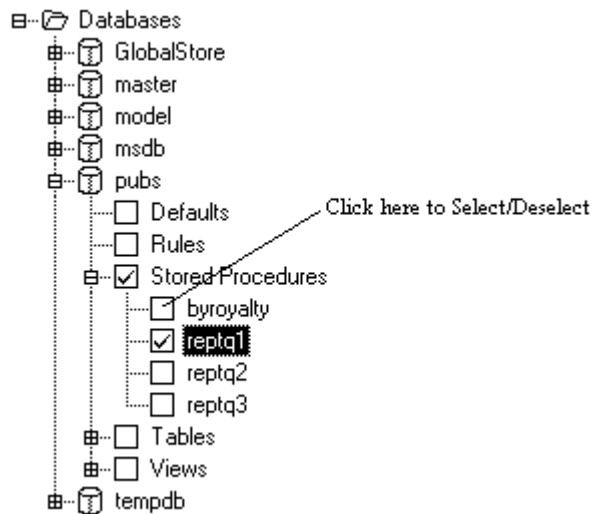

Installing Software

- If you want to run this software from a workstation connected to a Server running SQL Server 6.5, then you **must** install SQL Server 32-bit client utilities from the **SQL Server 6.5** CD on the workstation. You must, at least, select *SQL Enterprise Manager* from the list of utilities to be installed.
- **You must also use the Enterprise Manager to ensure that you can connect to the desired SQL Servers. This will save a lot time if you having problems connecting to the SQL Server.**
- Unzip SQLPRINT.ZIP file and run the setup.exe program to install the software.

Running Print SQL Server 6.5+ Dictionary

In order to save download time I have not supplied you with the following files essential to run this software. These files should already be on your system (in the system directory) after you have installed SQL Server or SQL Server client utilities. If they are not, you can copy them from the SQL Server CD (from /I386) into the system directory.
