# Steven's Casino Royale® ©Copyright 1996 Steven W. Lucey

Steven's Casino Royale is a Windows gambling casino that hosts 3 gambling games: BlackJack, Poker, and Craps. Players have a separate cash amount for each table that they can purchase chips with to place their bets. Players start with \$5000 cash at each of the tables. If any player goes bust at one of the tables, they will

be given another \$5000 to start the next time they visit that table. When leaving any of the tables, players are

shown the Top Five winners of that table and any chips that you have left will automatically be cashed-in. When you return to a table your previous cash amount will be available to you (unless as stated above you had went bust).

# Installation

For file archive (.ZIP): Unzip the archive into a directory of your choice. It is recommended, but not required,

that Steven's Casino Royale be given its own directory. After unzipping the files to your directory, move the (2) .DLL files to your Windows directory. Next, in Program Manager or from the Start button, create a program

icon within one of your groups or folders. Thats it!

For Diskette: Simply insert the diskette that contains Steven's Casino Royale into your floppy diskette and run

the INSTALL.EXE program. A directory will be created called 'Casino' and files will be copied

and

initialized. You will also be asked whether you wish to create a new program group (or folder) or

an existing one. Thats it!

On startup, you will be asked to enter your name and a unique password to use while in the Casino. In this way.

you and your friends/family can keep separate cash amounts of credit in the Casino and the Casino can keep track of the Top Five winners at the tables.

Also note, that at the bottom of this screen is a selection for your CPU speed. The CPU speed is needed to adjust

the animation of the dice at the craps table. You can adjust this when starting the program. NOTE: if you set this

to your CPU Speed and the animation is still too fast or too slow for your machine, you can always set it for another value even if it is not your true CPU Speed.

### How to play

Each gambling table is somewhat similar in style of play. This helps facilitate the player in play. Basically, upon

entering each table you will first Buy Chips using your available cash by clicking on the BUY CHIPS button.

Then you will place a bet by clicking one or more of your playing chips. As you click on the chip(s), you will

notice that the Bet Indicator will increase. After placing your bet, you may have the house/dealer deal the cards

(for BlackJack & Poker) or you may roll the dice (in Craps this is called a SHOOT). First time players should

select the PRO TIPS button once they have reached the tables which will give you more detailed info on

each game is played and some useful tips on playing.

#### Shareware

Steven's Casino Royale is distributed under the Shareware Concept. Shareware is not a pricing plan, but a method of distribution. You are allowed to evaluate this software for upto 30 days. After 30 days you will need to either register the software or delete the software from your hard drive (or run the uninstall program

if you obtained the shareware version on diskette). Until this software is registered, you will be reminded every time at startup that this software is unregistered. Also, the unregistered version will only start you out at \$500 rather than \$5000.

# Registering

When registering Steven's Casino Royale, you will need to click the button on the Main Menu called 'Register'. This will open the dialog window for you. On this screen you will find the Software ID number that \*MUST\* be sent along with the order form (see order.txt). Once the author has received your order form with the Software ID, and your Internet E-Mail address (if applicable), the author will send you your registration number that corresponds to the Name you wish to register the software by. If you wish to receive your registration number via E-Mail, simply include your E-Mail in the Order form on the appropriate line. All orders processed the same day they are received. Registrations are always good for any future upgrades regardless of whether it is a major or minor update to the software.
