Cribbage Scoring Rules

The Rank of Cards: The ace counts 1, the two 2, the three 3, and so on up to the ten-spot. The king, queen, and jack also count 10.

1. Each sum total of cards equaling 15 earns 2 points. (2-10-3)
2. Pairs. Two cards of the same denomination score 2 points.
3. Three of a Kind. Scores 6 points.
4. Four of a Kind. Scores 12 points.
5. A run of 3 or more cards. Scores one point per card.
6. Double Three-Card Run. (10-10-9-8), scores 8 points.
7. Double Four-Card Run. (10-10-9-8-7), scores 10 points.
8. Triple Run. (10-10-10-9-8), scores 15 points.
9. Quadruple Run. (10-10-9-9-8), scores 16 points.
10. Four-Card Flush. Four cards of the same suit in the hand without the starter scores 4 points.
11. Five-Card Flush. Five cards of the same suit in the hand with the starter scores 5 points.
12. Right Jack (His Nobs). Jack of the same suit as the starter, scores 1 point.
13. His Heels. Starter card is a Jack, scores 2 points.

After the starter card has been turned over, each column and row is scored by the computer and its score displayed on the adjacent score panel. Clicking on a row or columns score panel will provide a scoring breakdown for that row or column.

Play

The object of Cribbage Squares Solitaire is to build the best possible cribbage hands in both the rows and columns. Cards are dealt from the hand one at a time. You select the position to place this card by moving the mouse to that position and clicking the left mouse button.

When 16 cards have been dealt from the deck the computer will turn over the Starter card and then will score the hands based on the traditional rules of cribbage.

Your goal is to make the highest possible total score. You may consider that you 'win the game' if you reach 70.

Undo Last Move

Once you have positioned the dealt card it can be removed in one of three ways:

1) Select 'Undo Last Move' from the Options Menu.

or

2) Press the Delete key on your keyboard.

or

3) Right mouse click on the card you just played.

Undo is only one move deep. That is, you can only undo the last card played. If you wish to Undo more moves perhaps you should consider replaying the game using the same cards.

Replay Game

This feature allows you to play the same deck of cards again. The first time you replay a deck of cards you will be notified that your score will not be eligible for consideration as a high score. This notification will not appear for subsequent replays of the same deck.

To replay a deck of cards:

- 1) Select Replay Game (Same Cards) from the Game menu.
- or
- 2) Use the accelerator keystroke CTRL-R.
