About the context menus

Microsoft supplies a What's This? help context menu for items in a dialog box and on the desktop. Additional menu items appear on this context menu when using Norton programs. As you use your Norton programs, <u>context-click</u> on any item in a dialog box to receive this context menu.

About How To help

How To... help lets you access task related information respective to the dialog box you are in. For example, if you were in Rescue Disk, the How To... menu item could cascade to include task topics like:

- creating a rescue disk
- creating a rescue folder
- changing Rescue Disk options

If you clicked on "changing Rescue Disk options," the task would tell you how to open the Rescue Disk Options window. In the Rescue Disk Options window, the How To... menu item could cascade to include task topics like:

- adding new rescue items
- choosing format options

As you can see, changing the dialog box you are in reveals new task topics that can be accessed using the How To... menu.

About the Info Desk toolbar

Info Desk lets you choose what your help topics navigation buttons look like. The Windows standard default displays push buttons with text on it. Using Info Desk programs, you can change the appearance of these buttons to toolbar buttons. Toolbar buttons save space and they let you access all of the help features easier. If you want, you can turn off the menu bar since there is a toolbar button for just about every help feature. Info Desk Options let you choose how the toolbars look and what appears what tools appear on it. Configure this feature to your needs; you can go back to the Microsoft standard buttons at any time.

to close any dialog box or window, or to exit an application.

Press...

to select an available setting, or to move the cursor or focus up.
 to select an available setting, or to move the cursor or focus down.

to move the cursor or focus to the right.
 to move the cursor or focus to the left.

Home to move the cursor to the beginning of the field you are editing.

End to move the cursor to the end of the field you are editing.

Spacebar to toggle an option between enabled and disabled; or to press a button.

Alt+ to activate a drop-down list or combination box.

Tab to move the focus to the next control.

Shift+Tab to move the focus to the previous control.

Alt+Tab to switch to another open applications. **Alt+Spacebar** to activate the control menu.

Alt+F4 to close an application.
