


Creating a new Vocabulary

Step 1

To create a new vocabulary follow the steps below:


Select «New» in the «File» menu or choose the  icon on the toolbar.

If you didnt save the current file, Vocab will ask you if you want to save it.

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Step 2

Select «Define Vocabulary...» in the «Edit» menu

[Shortcut Ctrl+E] or choose the  icon on the toolbar.

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Step 3

Here you can select two desired languages and corresponding fonts..

You may select a predefined language or enter a custom language.

Please remember that the fonts are only for printing.

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Step 4

Now you have to enter the words/expressions into the table.


If the table isn't visible you will have to select «Table» in the «View» Menu.

You will only have to press enter after each word/expression and the selection will automatically jump to the next cell.

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Step 5

After you have finished your entry you can save your work on your hard drive.

For this, choose «Save» in the «File» Menu or you may select the  icon on the toolbar.

Creating a Query

Step 6

Now you can create a query:

- a) Switch the view to «Query» in the «View» menu.
- b) Choose «Query settings» in the «Query» menu.

Step 7

Here you can set various query settings.


For more information press F1 or select the «Help» button.


Creating a Query

Step 8

Now you will only have to choose the language in which you want to be tested.

Select «Query in...» in the «Query» menu choose the wished language.

Further you can choose between normal or multiple choice query with the  icon on the toolbar or by selecting «Multiple choice» in the «Query» menu.

Start now the query by selecting «Start» in the «Query» menu or choose the  icon on the toolbar.
