

This is my second Windows/Covox contribution. It's only slightly less pointless than my last one.. It will make audible key clicks as you type under windows. It gives three separate sounds, for the return key, the space bar, and for all the other keys. Unfortunately, unless you're a two-finger typist, it doesn't come closer to keeping up. And it get a bit annoying after a while, (I know I have it on as I write this!)

I set it up for my Voice Master. But I planned ahead. To change this, add these lines to your Win.Ini:

Port=0	Voice Master, Port 22Fh
Port=1	Voice Master, Port 24Fh
Port=2	Voice Master, Port 28Fh
Port=3	Voice Master , Port 2CFh
Port=4	Voice Master, LPT1
Port=5	Voice Master, LPT2
Port=6	Voice Master, LPT3

(I choose the Application name, in the hopes that this parameter could be used by many sound applications).
