

Click Index

The Index contains a list of all Help topics available for Click. You can use the scroll bars to see the entries that are not currently visible in the Help window.

For information on how to use Help, press F1 or choose Using Help from the Help menu.

While viewing the Click system menu, you may get context sensitive help by holding down the mouse button and pressing F1 while the item you want help on is selected. You may get context sensitive help from inside most of Click's dialog boxes by selecting the "Help" button in the dialog box.

Preferences

Preferences allows you to change the frequency and duration of the "click." Move the box in the scroll bars to the positions you like and then click OK. If you want to leave the old settings, click CANCEL.

Each time you move the box, a "click" reflecting the frequency and duration you have selected will be heard.

You may choose to have Click "click" on repeated keys (where a key is held down and letters continue appearing). To do this click "Don't click on repeated key" so that there is no "x" in the box. To not have Click "click" on repeated keys, click "Don't click on repeated key" so that there is an "x" in the box.

To revert to the default frequency and duration, click "Default".
