Hi,

after looking at some of the 'ways to go' to get People's Pictures into Mail.app, here's one more which works quite well for me :-). It's as far as I can see a lot easier than most others, so that you might want to give it a try...

I have a shellscript which is run by cron every now and then, I called it 'mailIconsDBupdate'

To get things up and running, just put your icons into  
/LocalLibrary/Images/People and give them names like this:

for jasch@gorga.en.open.de and oliver@sphinx.gun.de (for those who don't understand: it's the full eMail address with the suffix tiff :-)) If you want an icon to be assigned to multiple addresses, just make some links and you are done...
