Known Problems:

Release 3.1

The Compaq LTE notebook has a problem under NEXTSTEP Release 3.1 that requires a careful execution of a special procedure during installation. During the second phase of installation the

keyboard will not function at all. You must use Configure to add an entry for the integrated serial trackball and remove the standard entry for the PS/2 mouse. If the PS/2 mouse entry is not removed, your system's keyboard will not work when you reboot, and you will be unable to boot with the option **config=Default** to correct the problem. If you make an error at this stage, you'll have to reinstall NEXTSTEP onto your Compaq's disk.
