Known Problems:

- During installation, you must eject the NEXTSTEP boot floppy after the kernel has been loaded (you'll see the screen refresh at this point, and afterwards you'll start to see messages describing the various probes the kernel is performing). The system will hang If you haven't ejected the floppy disk by the time the floppy drive is probed.
- You should activate the keyboard at the "boot:" prompt by pressing the Enter key. Failing to do so may result in boot problems.
- Sleep mode may affect the system clock (date/time).
- Some older Ultralite Versas do not recognize all of the memory in memory cards larger than 8MB. This can be fixed by downloading a new version of the BIOS from the NEC BBS. Call NEC technical support or read the Versa user's guide for more detailed information.
