

UPDATED PENTHOUSE INTERACTIVE PROGRAMS

(Windows Users Only)

Why they are needed

Due to a change in QuickTime for Windows (an Apple Computer product used on Penthouse Interactive under license) sometimes users experience errors. An example is the "UNDEFINED DYNALINK" error message.

The reason this occurs is that Penthouse Interactive releases 1, 2 and 3 use QuickTime for Windows release 1.1.1. Currently many products are using the new QuickTime for Windows 2.0 (as does Penthouse Interactive release 4). If you have the old release of QuickTime for Windows and the 2.0 release on your system at the same time errors may occur.

To prevent these errors, we have provided new Windows programs for Penthouse Interactive 1, 2 and 3. You will still need your PHI 1, 2 or 3 CD-ROM to use these programs.

How to use these updated Penthouse Interactive Programs

(We use PHI2 as an example, do the same steps for PHI 1, 2 or 3)

1. Install Penthouse Interactive 2 per the normal instructions.
2. Take the PHI 2 CD-ROM out of your CD-ROM drive.
3. Place the Penthouse Interactive release 4 CD into your CD-ROM drive.
4. Switch to the E:\WINFIXES\PHI2 directory
5. Using File Manager (looks like a file cabinet) copy PHI2.EXE to the PHI directory on your C: drive.

OR If you are more comfortable using DOS, you may copy the file using the following (assuming your CD-ROM drive is E:)

```
> COPY E:\WINFIXES\PHI2\PHI2.EXE C:\PHI
```

6. Remember, this procedure should be used for PHI1 or PHI3 as well.
