

Voice Selection

The voice selection dialog box allows the voice used by the current application to be selected. Voices can also be removed and installed using this dialog.

To choose a new voice:

- o Select the voice from the list and press OK. Voices which are on the CD-ROM will not be listed unless they have been copied to the hard disk or the CD-ROM is present. After selecting a voice which is on the CD-ROM, you will be asked if you want to copy it to the hard disk. The voice will always be available if copied to the hard disk. It will be available *only* when the CD-ROM is present if you do not choose this option.

To exit without changing the voice:

- o Press Cancel.

To configure a voice:

- o Choose the voice and press the Voice button. Some voices (such as Make-Your-Own) allow for further configuration. Others will simply display information about the voice.

To copy a voice from CD-ROM to the hard disk:

- o Select the voice
- o Press the Copy from CD-ROM button. This button will not be available if the voice cannot be located on the CD-ROM, or if the voice is already on the hard disk.

Note: The uncompressed versions of many of the voices are very large, typically 5-10 MB. You may want to install a compressed version of the selected voice instead.

To remove a voice from the hard disk:

- o Select the voice
- o Press the Remove from hard disk button. This button will not be available if the voice cannot be located on CD-ROM, or if the voice is not on the hard disk.
