### **Welcome to the Q·Media for Windows Sampler CD!**

This file contains important information regarding the Release 2.0 Sampler CD. The Q·Media Sampler CD has a full working version of Q·Media (with the save feature disabled), two sample movies, templates, and a self-running introduction to Q·Media Release 2.0.

When you install the software, Q·Media for Windows, the multimedia drivers for animation and video, along with the sample files are copied onto your hard disk.

A self running introduction is also contained on the CD. An icon is installed in your Windows Program manager called Run Me First. Opening this will run the demo. For the best results however, we recommend running the demo from DOS.

### **Important information about the Q·Media 2.0 CD Sampler:**

1. For best results run the self running demo in DOS.
2. The self running demo includes narration and sound. If you have a sound card installed, but you do not hear any audio - insure that your sound card is Sound Blaster compatible and the proper DOS drivers are loaded.

### **Known Driver Problems with Q·Media 2.0:**

The most common cause of problems or GPF's with Q·Media 2.0 is incompatible or out dated video drivers. To achieve greater display performance some video drivers sacrifice full compatibility with Windows applications. If you are experiencing GPF's with Q·Media 2.0 we recommend trying the standard VGA drivers supplied with Windows 3.1. If the GPF's stop it is likely you have an out of date video driver.

Q·Media 2.0 has been tested with a wide variety of graphics, video, and sound cards. The problems we encountered are listed below. We are currently working with the manufacturers to ensure 100% compatibility in the near future.

1. Diamond VIPER and SPEEDSTAR PRO video drivers can cause a GPF with a 1024x768 stage. Other stage sizes are okay.
