

“AddToProgMan” is a Word for Windows macro that will allow you to create an Icon for a document in your Program Manager group of choice. It will prompt you for the filename, the title (i.e. what shows up under the icon), the group name, and the icon name. It will then, if you request it to do so, have the Program Manager add an icon for that file.

For this macro to be of use, though, it is best installed with your global macros (in NORMAL.DOT). This is most easily done by double clicking on the button below:

Double click on this button to install: **Install**
