

# The Windows Killer

The Windows Killer is a very little application, which allows a quick exit from Windows, a restart of Windows or even booting the PC from within Windows at the click of the mouse. When the program is started it displays a Message Window saying Hello and it is immediately active, after that. Just click at the icon, and select the appropriate menu item. That is all. The annoying "Do you really want to quit" is bypassed. Therefore the program is a kind of dangerous. If all applications agree the procedure can not be stopped. There is no help build in, because there is no help necessary. If you do not understand the menulines, stop using this program!

If you want to start this program in the autostart group of windows 3.1 add any non blank command-line when installing the program. This avoids the opening Message Window. Thanks to N.N. for suggesting this.

This program is written for use with Windows 3.1. It should run with Windows 3.0 anyway. The only difference is that the **Boot PC** option is disabled under windows 3.0

It should be noted that this program relies completely on the use of the Windows API functions. No dirty tricks! Therefore it should be reliable.
