

Wave Player v2.0

Wave Player is a Windows program that has many functions, including playing wave sound files. Since Wave Player takes advantage of the new Win 3.1 API, it will only run in Windows version 3.1 or higher. In this version, 2.0, I have made many new improvements: arranging icons and displaying how many programs are running, shelling out to DOS, emptying the clipboard to free memory, swaping mouse buttons, and displaying the date and time. I have also improved it by making the window resizeable, and making the program smaller and run faster. It's functions are as follows: plays sound files, shells out to DOS, empties the clipboard, swaps mouse buttons, displaying the date and time, launches other programs, displays Free System Resources, displays Available Memory, gives you version information about MSDOS and Windows, tells you how long Windows has been running, tells you how many tasks(programs) are currently running, arranges the icons in the main window, restarts Windows, and reboots your computer. To play wave files(files that have the extension .wav), you must have a sound driver installed for Windows or no sounds will play. If you do not have a sound driver installed, you can obtain one from a local BBS or from Microsoft. It will let you play the wave files on your regular PC Speaker. Read you Windows manual to find out how to install the sound driver. The following is a table which tells how to access each function:

<u>Menu Item</u>	<u>Function</u>
Open	Opens and plays a sound file
Run	Launches or runs another program
Shell to Dos	Lets you shell to Dos
Exit	Exits Wave Player
Restart Windows	Restarts Windows
Reboot Computer	Restarts computer
Date & Time	Displays the date and time
Tasks Running	Tells how many programs are running
Version Info	Displays version information about MSDOS and Windows
Free System Resources	Displays percentage of free system resources
Memory	Displays available memory
Time Running	Displays how long Windows has been running since it was last started
Empty Clipboard	Empties Clipboard to free memory
Swap Mouse Buttons and	Makes the right mouse button the main button visa versa
Arrange Icons	Arranges the icons in the main window
About	Tells about the program
