Change a user's group membership

You can also change the default group—the group that by default is associated with the user's files.

1 Log in as root on any network computer.

If you don't log in as **root**, you can type the **root** password when you start UserManager.

2 Double-click UserManager in /NextAdmin.

- 5 Choose Groups from the pop-up list in the user's window

- 6 Select a domain and a group, and then click Add, Remove, or Make€Default.

When you click Add, a check mark appears next to the group. You can add the user to as many groups as you want.

When you click Make Default, a star appears next to the group. (Be sure you click Add to add the user to the group before you click Make Default.)
