

# DECchip 21040/21041 Based Network Adapter Driver

## Network Devices Network.tiff ,

This device driver is designed to run on an Intel-based computer running OPENSTEP for Mach Release 4.1. It automatically detects the target adapter.

### Supported Hardware:

This driver supports DECchip 21040 and 21041 based ethernet adapters.

### Installation and Configuration Steps:

1. Install the adapter in the system (if necessary).
2. Log in as root and run Configure.
3. Click on the Network Devices icon at the top of Configure's "Summary of Devices" window. In the Add Network Devices panel that opens, select the radio button labeled "Show Drivers for Detected Devices" if it is not already highlighted.
4. Select "DECchip 21040/21041 Based Adapter" from the list, and click Add.
5. Click Done, then click Save, then quit Configure.
