I've had a ton of requests for these, so rather than replying individually, I'm sending the whole thing to the list. The following is a directory called **flags** (note, it's a *directory*, the icon you see is just a .dir.tiff linked to one of the icons, or *should* be a link if NeXTMail didn't keep changing it to a real file FaceSad.tiff →). This directory contains all the country flag icons that I have. Each icon is LZW compressed (yes, I know NeXTMail also compresses, but they're already LZW'd to save space on my disk, so there it is).

Well, after the UK flag update, I thought there are reasons for an even more profound update of the Swiss flag.

It has been forgotten (and what most non-Swiss forget) that the Swiss flag is square-shaped. And please don't argue that all flags in this archive are rectangular - Nepal isn't either :)

I blew it up, cut left & right parts and reassembled it. However, for many practical reasons, I prefer TIFFany II over Wet Paint.

Yet another remark: the name of "Czechoslovakia" should be "Czech Republic" - the Slovaks have a different flag. We are dealing with two nations now...
