Running the Club KidSoft CD for the First Time

The first time that you run Club KidSoft on your Club KidSoft CD, you must register your CD-ROM disc. By registering, you are uniquely identifying your computer which enables the software unlocking technology. We know it all sounds very confusing and high tech, but trust us, it works.

The recommended requirements for the Club KidSoft CD are a minimum of 4 megabytes of RAM, a 486DX-25 cpu or better, and a double-speed CD-ROM. The disc will run on a single speed, but the screen change time will be extremely slow and the QuickTime movies may become jumpy. The display must also be set to a minimum of 256 colors.

- 1) Place the CD-ROM in the drive**
- 2) Open the Club KidSoft CD program group or tab.**
- 3) Double-click on the Club KidSoft CD icon**

- 1) From the Start Menu, under programs choose Club KidSoft
- 2) Under Club KidSoft, choose Club KidSoft CD 1

Registering is easy! Simply look below the CD, inside the CD packaging, for a 14 character Registration Code and an 8 character Key Code. Enter the 14 letters in the first box of the registration window. Press the TAB key and enter the 8 character Key Code. When you finish, click on the register button and you're on your way!!

Your CD should have come preinstalled on your **COMPAQ** Presario. However, if for some reason your files become damaged or you need to reinstall your Club KidSoft CD for whatever reason, follow these instructions:

- 1) Place the CD-ROM in the CD-ROM drive
- 2) On the command bar, click on FILE, then click on RUN
- 3) In the command line type **D:\setup** (assuming that D: is your CD-ROM drive.)
- 4) When asked for an installation path for the CD, just click on the OK button
- 5) Once installation is complete, a program group call *Club KidSoft CD* will be created. Inside the program group will be an icon titled Club KidSoft CD 1. Double-click on this icon to start the CD.

The Electronic Documentation Viewer

Some of the products available for unlocking from the Club KidSoft CD also come with electronic documentation. By this we mean that the normal paper manual for the program has been scanned and transformed into a file that can be viewed on your computer.

However, in order to view these electronic manuals, you must have a viewing program installed on your computer. Double-clicking on the Install Documentation Viewer icon will install the Adobe Acrobat document viewer to your computer. After installation, you will be able to read the electronic manual for the products you unlock.

When you do unlock a program with electronic documentation, the icon for the document will be placed in the Club KidSoft CD program group. Simply double-click that icon to load the manual to view on screen and print.

NOTE: It is not mandatory to install the Adobe Acrobat viewer immediately after setting up the Club KidSoft CD. Only when you unlock a product that comes with an electronic manual will you need to have Adobe Acrobat installed.

Problems with Video Drivers

If you have an older video card or incompatible video drivers in your computer, you may experience problems while trying to run the Club KidSoft CD. These problems can appear as General Protection Faults, application errors, error messages referring to *getPixel()* errors, or a garbled picture on the screen. In most cases, these problems can be fixed by updating your video driver to the most recent version. You should contact your video card manufacturer to find out if there is a newer version of your video driver.

If you received General Protection Faults using the CD with a Diamond Speedstar Pro video accelerator you need to contact Cirrus Logic to install the most current version of the Cirrus Logic 5426/5428 video drivers. Installing these will correct the problem. The Cirrus Logic bulletin board number is (510) 440-9080.

The Club KidSoft CD contains the most recent release of the Windows video drivers for Trident video cards and video cards containing Quadtel chipsets.

To install these drivers go to your File Manager and follow these steps:

- 1) Click on the CD-ROM drive icon (i.e. D:)
- 2) Double-click on the DRIVERS folder on the left hand side.
- 3) Double-click on the TRIDENT folder on the left hand side.
- 4) On the right hand side on the screen, double-click on the file TINSTALL.EXE to begin the installation procedure.

Follow the on screen instructions to install these most recent drivers.

NOTE: YOU MUST HAVE YOUR WINDOWS DISKETTES HANDY DURING THIS INSTALL.

If you have an ATI Mach 32 or Mach 64 video card, do the following:

- 1) In your ATI video card control panel in Windows, turn the WinSwitching option to OFF.
- 2) From the Menu Bar at the top of the screen click on FILE then click on RUN
- 3) In the command box type SYSTEM.INI and click the OK button
- 4) Scroll through the SYSTEM.INI file until you find a section in brackets labeled MACX or ATI INTERCEPTOR
- 5) Within that section, insert a blank line and add the line: DEVICEBITMAP=OFF
- 6) Close and save the SYSTEM.INI file.
- 7) Restart Windows for the change to take effect.

NOTE: Making these changes has no harmful effects.

Make sure you typed the command line in exactly as it says in the Club KidSoft booklet. If you have, eject the CD and clean the back with some glass cleaner and a soft cloth. Then try to reinstall the CD using the File Manager located under the Main program group or tab.

Some of the demos on the CD are DOS demos. In order to use your mouse in these demos a DOS mouse driver must be loaded when you boot up the computer. The line that loads this driver will be located in either your AUTOEXEC.BAT or CONFIG.SYS file. Either consult your DOS User's Guide or contact your *COMPAQ* technical support representative to make sure this driver is being loaded when you start the computer.

This is correct. Some of the demos on the CD are DOS demos. This means that when you run them from Windows, they cannot share the sound card with Windows. A message box will appear before you enter the demo that will let you know if the demo will be running without sound.

Try to do a soft boot (press CTRL + ALT + DEL on the keyboard.) to restart your computer. If a soft boot will not work, manually turn off the computer, wait about 10 seconds and turn the computer back on. While the computer is rebooting, take the CD out of the drive and clean off the shiny side with glass cleaner and a soft cloth, to insure there are no smudges or fingerprints interfering with the reading of the CD. Reinsert the CD and try again. If problems persist, call our technical support line at (408) 255-3434 .

No. See the section in the Troubleshooting menu regarding COMPAQ users running TabWorks.

Yes. Think of QuickTime as a movie projector that is necessary to run most multimedia titles that contain animation and sound. Updating your QuickTime files is like getting a more powerful projector.

TABWORKS USERS NOTE!!

You must turn off the File Tracking option before installing the Club KidSoft CD. The instructions for doing this are as follows:

- 1. Start by selecting OPTIONS on the TabWorks menu bar**
- 2. Select FILE TRACKING...**
- 3. Turn off TRACK FILE CREATION and TRACK FILE MODIFICATION by clicking on the X in the box next to each item.**
- 4. Click on OK to close that menu.**
- 5. Click on FILE on the menu bar and click on RUN.**
- 6. In the command line type D:\SETUP and click OK.**
- 7. At the first window that comes up, click OK.**
- 8. Follow the on screen instructions after installation to return to windows.**
- 9. Click on FILE in the menu bar and click on SAVE BOOK to ensure that you do not lose the KidSoft tab.**
- 10. Double-click on the Club KidSoft icon in TabWorks and follow the on screen instruction to register the disc.**
- 11. HAVE FUN!!!**

If QuickTime fails to initialize, clean the back of the CD with glass cleaner or rubbing alcohol and a soft cloth and reinstall following the Quick Start instructions in the CD sleeve.

You most likely have more than one hard disk. If you changed the installation path of the KidSoft CD during installation (i.e. c:\kidsoft\v3issue1 became d:\kidsoft\v3issue1), you need to choose FILE from the task bar at the top of the screen and choose RUN. Type KIDSOFT.INI and press OK. Look for the section in the INI file that relates to the issue of the CD you are experiencing problems with (Volume 3 Issue 2, etc.) Change all the lower case drive letters to upper case. For example, change d:\demos to D:\demos. Exit and save the KIDSOFT.INI file. This will fix the problem.

If you get this message, remove the CD from the drive and spray the back of the CD with glass cleaner or rubbing alcohol and a soft cloth. Place the disc back in the drive and try the Quick Start instructions again. If you still get the same message click on CANCEL to close all windows and follow these directions:

1. Click on the MAIN program group or tab.
2. Double-click on the FILE MANAGER icon
3. On the drive bar at the top of the file manager window, click on the D: drive.
4. On the left side of the screen, click on the yellow folder that says D:\.
5. On the right side of the screen, click on the file labeled SETUP.EXE.
6. If a box comes up saying 'Setup is Initializing...Please Wait', then follow the on screen instruction to install. If you still get the same error message call 1-800-354-6150 to request a replacement CD.

This message occurs when trying to run DOS demos from the Club KidSoft CD and there is not enough lower DOS conventional memory available.

Check the section in your MS DOS manual for the section concerning the utility called MEMMAKER. Follow the instructions for running this utility. When finished, you can run the DOS demos with no problems.

The Club KidSoft CD was meant to be run in a video mode that supports 256 colors or more if your video card can handle it. If you received the error message saying you are running in a video mode of less than 256 colors, your computer is most likely set to standard VGA mode which only supports 16 colors.

To change your video mode contact your manufacturer's technical support representative to have them help you change your video driver to 256 colors.

The most common problem during registration is not typing the code correctly. Make sure you double check all the letters in your 14 character alphabetic registration code and in your 9 character key code. Both of these codes must be entered correctly to access the CD. They need only be entered the first time you register the CD.

If you have double checked and made sure the code is same as the one on the back of your CD sleeve, call 1-800-354-6150 and request another registration code from our product specialists.

To jump to the second box for entering your key code,
press the TAB key on your keyboard. It is located on the left hand side
CAPS LOCK key.

This error occurs when files necessary for processing your registration information do not get properly installed to your hard drive. Take the CD out of the drive and clean the back with some glass cleaner or rubbing alcohol and a soft cloth. Then place the CD back in the drive and follow the PC Quick Start instruction in the CD sleeve.

Shopping in the KidSoft SuperStore

Purchasing from the Club KidSoft CD-ROM

To purchase a product, click the BUY NOW button on the bottom right of the screen. If you have already selected your product, this will take you directly to the Purchase Screen. If you have not selected a product, click on the BUY NOW button from the title screen to be taken to the **FIND** screen so that you may locate the product you would like to purchase. You will then be taken to the product detail screen. Click BUY NOW again and you will be taken to the Purchase Screen.

Once you are in the Purchase Screen, and have your product selected, call Club KidSoft at **1-800-354-6150**.

If this product is unlockable, you will see a Customer Code printed in red in the lower right corner of the screen. This is the code you give to the KidSoft product specialist to unlock the product from the CD. Your KidSoft product specialist will give you a 14 character unlock code. Once you type the unlock code into the box on your screen, the software will be unlocked and ready for installation. This code will only work with the CD you installed on your computer. After the product has been unlocked, the installation instructions will appear in the product detail screen. If you have any problems, your product specialist will assist you in the installation process.

You also have the option to purchase any product through mail order. If the selected product is only available by Mail Order, you will see a picture of a package that will say KIDSOFT MAIL ORDER. Call **1-800-354-6150** to order and have the product shipped to you within 2 days.

Installing, and Re-installing Software

After you unlock a program, choose to Install Now or Install Later. You can always reinstall a purchased piece of software again.

Whenever you choose Install Now, the Club KidSoft application will either:

- 1) Run the purchased software's installer if there is one.
- 2) Copy the files to your boot-up hard disk drive to a specific folder. All the directory and file information will be displayed on screen. Write this information down for future reference.

When you choose Install Later, the Club KidSoft CD will remember what you've purchased. You can install that unlocked product by clicking on the UNLOCKED PRODUCTS button on the first screen in the Club KidSoft application. On the next screen, click on the product in the list you wish to install. Click on the INSTALL button to install that product. Once you have unlocked a software program, the software remains unlocked on the disc, but may be used only on the computer from which you made the software purchase.

Getting a piece of software from the Club KidSoft CD onto your computer is a two step process. First you must unlock the software, then you need to install it to the hard disk inside your computer.

Unlocking a piece of software is like getting the key for a door that needs only be opened once. After you receive your unlocking code for a program, you have access for installing and reinstalling that program as many times as you please.

Installing the software is the process that actually transfers the program from the CD into your computer. After the CD has accepted your unlocking code the first time you will, from then on, find your product listed in the UNLOCKED PRODUCTS screen. You get to this screen by clicking on the UNLOCKED PRODUCTS button at the title screen. Simply highlight the product you wish to reinstall and click on the INSTALL button to the right. This will start the installation engine that came with that particular program. Follow the on screen instructions and the program will be reinstalled to your computer.

NOTE: If you are planning to reinstall a program it is usually a good idea to completely delete the old version of that program from the hard disk using the Windows File Manager. See your Windows manual for detailed information.

The KidSoft files take up approximately 1.8 MB of hard disk space.

For deleting the KidSoft files from your hard disk do the following:

1. Open the MAIN program group or tab.
2. Double-click on the FILE MANAGER icon
3. At the top of the File Manager, click on the C: drive icon
4. On the left hand side look for the yellow folder marked KIDSOFT and double-click it.
5. Look for the yellow folder that branches off from KIDSOFT that corresponds to the CD issue you want to delete (i.e. V3issue1).
6. Click once to highlight the issue folder and press DELETE on your keyboard.
7. For the boxes that come up on screen, click on OK, then YES TO ALL, the YES TO ALL again.

NOTE: To delete the icons for Club KidSoft, simply highlight the icon, press DELETE on the keyboard and click on the YES button when it comes up.

If you already know the title of the product you wish to purchase, from the Club KidSoft screen, click on the BUY NOW button. Find the title you wish to unlock from the product list and click on it. When the product screen comes up click on the BUY NOW button in the lower right hand corner. This will bring up the ordering screen. Call 1-800-354-6150 to have one of our product specialists help you unlock and install your software.

There is no need to make separate backup copies of the software you unlock. Once you enter your unlocking codes for a product, it can be installed and reinstalled again from the CD at no charge. The CD itself acts as the backup copy.

If you experience a hard disk crash and lose all your data including KidSoft, simply reinstall the CD, reenter your registration code and call 1-800-354-6150 to receive new unlocking codes for your products, absolutely free!!

Nope! The only reason you need to enter the registration code found below the CD (other than to get into the CD) is so if you ever decide to order a product from the Club KidSoft CD, the customer code you give the product specialist will be unique to your CD.
