

EMACS commands for Word 4.0

To use: Select the **Commands...** option from the **Edit** menu, and **Open** the file EMACS Word Settings.

Many common EMACS commands are supported. The following mapping of shift keys is used:

Real EMACS

Control-

Meta-

Control-Meta-

Word pseudo-EMACS

Command-

Command-Option-

Not available

What's available: most of the standard motion commands (C-b, C-f, C-n, C-p, M-f, M-b, C-a, C-e, M-a, M-e, M-[, M-]); editing commands (C-d, delete, M-d, M-delete); kill and yank to one level (C-w, C-y); search and replace (C-s and M-%).

Warning: the behavior of Word commands is different in subtle ways from real EMACS (for instance, forward word (Meta-F) in real EMACS leaves the cursor before the terminating space, while Word's equivalent command leaves it after). You may find this extremely irritating.
