

his example was created without any additional markings for tempo or dynamics so that even readers without Finale's Petrucci font would see an accurate, if minimalistic, music picture. All here is bitmapped save the word "piccolo" which was typed in Times 10 pt.

Slurs and ties seem to look best when added as curves in the Edit Picture window of MSWord 5.0. If any editing of the music needs to occur, this window will open by double-clicking on the measure(s) in question. Here, separately added markings may be added individually. Note, however, that it is occasionally best to return to one's original Finale document to complete more basic editing procedures.

I hope this is helpful to all of you budding musicologists like myself. If anyone knows of any comprehensive music program which allows an easier Copy function than Finale does, please write me:
