


In Recording Aid, each new recording is treated as a separate file which must be opened, filled, and finally closed. The vehicle for entering the information for a song is the Add song dialog box under the Album menu. It looks like this:



Enter the following information:

Time:



By entering the required information, the song will be entered into the current file.
The syntax for the time field is as follows: X:XX.

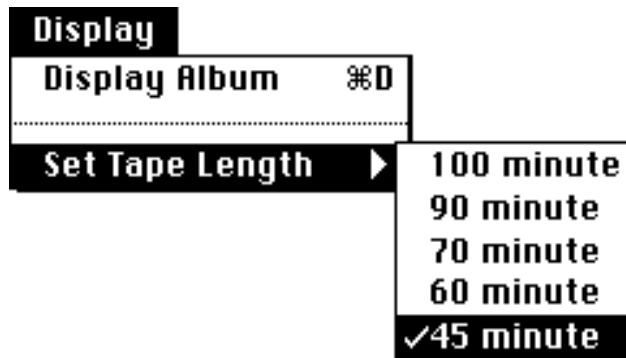
After entering all the necessary data, choose Display from the Display menu. The album will be presented in the main window as an index card view. Both sides will be shown, and the total times will be displayed for each side. The display should look similar to this:



Side A: 21:19	Side B: 21:49
Immigrant Song	Gallows Pole
Friends	Tangerine
Celebration Day	That's the way
Since I've been loving you	Bron-Y-Aur Stomp

If the album is too long for the tape, you will be instructed to select a longer tape length under the Display menu. The tape lengths are hidden in a hierarchical menu under

the item name, Set Tape Length.
