

## GetRight More Configuration

Over the course of creating GetRight, several items that a user can change were added within the program, but for whatever reason, there was no item added on the Configuration window to set or change the item. This program lets you easily set and change these extra options.

- **User Agent:** To make GetRight send something different as the "User-Agent" in a HTTP request. If this is left blank, then GetRight will send it's own user agent--the exact text includes the version number, so is different for each version of GetRight.  
NOTE: Some sites have "blocked" GetRight for various reasons--like the features to find the fastest server does ping their server periodically and some don't like that--or because it can keep trying to connect if the server is busy. Changing this may let you get back in--but they can block your IP address completely so you can't get in with ANY program. So Beware!
- **Send "Referer" in HTTP requests:** GetRight (like your web browser) sends a "referer" header to tell the server where you clicked on a link to the file. GetRight does calculate a value from your web browser for this, but it can easily be the wrong one if you have several browser windows open. Uncheck this to not send *any* calculated referer information. This over-rides the next item to send a generated value.
- **Send "Referer" generated from server name of the download:** GetRight can also send a generated value for the "referer". The value is generated as: **http://server/index.html** where server is the server name from the URL with the file. This will help with some servers that do checks that you clicked on the link to the URL from their web site--and GetRight is getting the referer from the wrong browser window. Or if you wish to send more anonymous "referers".
- **Icons:** Click the button to select any icon .ICO file to use for the icon. Click "Cancel" on the open file window to clear the icon.
- **Animated Drag-Drop Window Icon:** To make the icon on the GetRight Drag-Drop window icon spin like on the individual download windows. This over-rides any different icon you have chosen for the window.  
NOTE: You must restart GetRight after making this change.
- **Double-Click tray icon opens GetRight Drag-Drop Window:** By default, GetRight opens the Download Status when you double click the GetRight logo tray icon. Check this to make it instead open the GetRight Drag-Drop Window.
- **"Tools" submenu in Tray Icon menu:** You may change so the items in the GetRight tray icon Tools submenu are not in a submenu and are in the initial tray icon menu. (Like the way it was in GetRight 3.2 and earlier.)
- **Hangup Prompt Timer (Seconds):** When using the "Hangup When Done" item, GetRight uses a default 30 second timer to let someone cancel in case the computer is in use. You may change the timer here.
- **Shutdown Prompt Timer (Seconds):** When using the "Turn Off Computer When Done" item, GetRight uses a default 30 second timer to let someone cancel in case the computer is in use. You may change the timer here.
- **Do Web Page Processor if download a web page:** You can have GetRight never start it's web page processor when it downloads a web page. (If GetRight is in "Automatic" mode, it won't prompt you to process the web page either.)
- **Debug web browser click monitoring:** For a few people, the GetRight click monitoring has stopped working. To help figure out why, you can turn on Debugging for the GetRight click monitoring. A **GetRightClick.log** file in the directory where GetRight is installed will be used to store information about the GetRight click monitoring.  
NOTE: You should **NOT** do this unless you are having problems with GetRight **NOT** catching clicks in your web browser. The log file may slow things down as it gets large--and it can grow quickly.  
NOTE: You must restart your web browser after changing this value.
