

What is SpamOff

SpamOff is simply in use tool for mail checking and killing spam messages. It allows you to check and filter your e-mail from several POP accounts. All deleted mail can be stored in the specified file.

When SpamOff runned you can see the mace icon in the taskbar near the clock. Right mouse click on this icon shows you the popup menu:

[Kill list...](#)

[Check mail now...](#)

Show result displays [Result form](#)

You should configure you [Mail options](#).

After the mail options configuring you can use SpamOff as mail checker only. If you want to kill spam messages in your POP accounts you should also configure [Kill list](#).

SpamOff downloads only the message headers without their bodies and works faster then you can clear spam manually.

SpamOff checks and filters your e-mail from several POP accounts simultaneously.

Mail options

Mail options dialog consists of two pages:

Common options - common SpamOff options.

Login Options - user accounts settings.

Login Options:

SpamOff can check and filter your e-mail from several POP accounts simultaneously. To create new user account click New account button.

After this fill the following fields :

- POP Server** - This is the machine name of the e-mail server on your network.
- Port** - This is the port that you need to connect to check your e-mail. Unless you know the port to be different, it should be the standard POP port of 110.
- Login name** - This is your e-mail user ID (or Login ID.) Make sure all proper punctuation and capitalization is observed.
- Password** - Type in your e-mail password (or Login Password.) Do not worry, this password will not be displayed on the screen, or anywhere else.
- Active** - Mail on this account will be checked only when Active check box is checked.
- Kill spam** - When Kill spam check box is checked all messages on the mail box will be checked on spam. If you want to check mail on the account only leave this check box unchecked.

Common options:

Common options page contains the following settings.

On new mail group defines what SpamOff should do when new mail received:

- Show result** - if checked SpamOff opens Result form
- Run mail reader** - if checked SpamOff runs mail reader specified in the edit field
- Play sound** - if checked SpamOff play specified wave file
- Save deleted messages** - if checked SpamOff store deleted messages (spam) in the user specified file.
- Check every** - (in minutes) shows the period of time in which your mail will be checked.
- Check mail on start** - if checked SpamOff checks mail on start.

Kill list

Kill list allows you to specify templates of messages you want to be deleted as spam.

You can create, delete and edit your own filters.

For creating new filter press **New** button. Specify **Header Condition** and **Text**.

Header may be one of the following values : "From:", "Subject:", "Cc:", "Reply-To:", "Return-Path:", "To:"
They are corresponding to appropriate mail header sections.

Condition is one of the following values "contains", "doesn't contain". In the list Filters they
corresponding to "=" and "<>" accordingly.

Text should contain the text from the appropriate part of the mail header

For example you want to kill all messages that arrive from billy@hotmail.com. You should fill following fields:

Header	From:
Condition	contains
Text	billy@hotmail.com

As a result you'll see the line "From: = billy@hotmail.com" in the filters list.

How to register

Until you don't register SpamOff, it will show you reminding message every 30 minutes.
Register SpamOff and receive full functionally version without reminding messages.

If you want to register Spam Off, you can do the registration online on the Internet at <http://www.shareit.com/programs/103425.htm>. Alternatively, you can go to <http://www.shareit.com> and enter the program number there: 103425. If you do not have access to the Internet, you can register via phone, fax or postal mail.

Result form

Result form appears automatically when new mail is arrived and *Show result* option is checked in the Mail options dialog. For more details see [Mail options](#).

To see the result form manually click Show Result item in the popup menu.

Result form has account list at the left side. You can see every account as a colour folder.

- Green folder** - there are new messages appropriate mailbox
- Red folder** - an error occurred during the checking process
- Yellow folder** - appropriate mailbox is empty or doesn't contain any new messages.
- Crossed out folder** - this account is not active. To make it active make *Active* checkbox in the Mail options dialog checked. For more details see [Mail options](#).

Status panel at the bottom of the dialog shows current status of each account.

At the right side of Result form you can see the messages headers which contain in the selected account. The right bottom side of Result form contains the following buttons :

- Update mailbox** - updates information about messages containing in the selected mailbox. SpamOff rereads mail messages headers and shows them.
- Mail reader** - runs Mail reader to read mail. Mail reader must be previously determined in the [Mail options](#) dialog.
- Close** - Close button closes Result form.

Check mail now menu item force mail checking immediately
You can stop the mail checking process by clicking Stop checking menu item.

Stop checking menu item stops current mail checking process.
In case it can't stop it immediately, please, wait for several seconds.
