Getting Around in the Microsoft Home CD Sampler

There are four buttons in the main menu of the CD Sampler: Introduction, Products, Help, and Exit. By clicking on these buttons with the left mouse key, you can navigate through the CD Sampler. When a category is selected it will be highlighted in grey.

Choose a product to view from any of the categories by clicking on the product box icon. You can then read information from any of the tabs, or view a demo by clicking **View Demo**. There will be a brief pause while the demo loads into memory. You can exit a demo and return to the Sampler at any time by pressing the ESC key on your keyboard.

► **Overview**

Overview provides a general description of the product. For many of the products you can view a demonstration by clicking **View Demo**. There will be a brief pause while the demo is loading into memory. You may exit a demo before it completes by pressing the ESC key on your keyboard. For some products you can click on the **Install (*item*)** button to set up the product on your local computer or copy a Shortcut to your desktop.

► **Features**

Highlights gives examples of things that make the software more productive, and shows you how these products can be easier to use.

► **Try These!**

Try These! suggests other Microsoft products similar to the one you're viewing, or products which complement that product.

Note ➡

To access MSN forums, you must be running Windows 95.

You can use a shortcut for quicker access to your favourite programs, without having to remember where the program is located.

To install a shortcut to the MSN forums on your desktop of Bookshelf Intro Edition, Car Source, Cinemania, Encarta Intro Edition, Music Central, Publisher or Works simply click the **Install Shortcut** button in the Overview tab.

To manually create a shortcut to a program after it has been installed, click and hold the program icon, and then drag the icon onto your desktop and let go. This will create a desktop shortcut that you can click to start the program. You can also follow the following steps:

1. Select the **File** menu on Top Menu Bar.
2. Select the **Create Shortcut** command.

Installing the Custom Entertainment Pack

Installing Fury3 Trial Version

To Install Fury3 Trial Version from the CD Sampler

For Windows 95 Users:

1. Select the **Fury3** product button from either the Entertainment or **Sports & Games** or in **New for Windows 95** categories.
2. At the Overview tab, click the **Install Game** button.
3. Follow the directions until installation is complete.

Note ➡

To play Fury3 you must quit the CD Sampler after installation, then select **Fury3 Trial Version** from the **Programs: Fury3 Trial Version** group on the **Start** menu.

For Windows 3.1 or Windows for Workgroups 3.1 users:

1. Select the Fury3 product button from either the **Entertainment** or **Sports & Games** categories
2. At the Overview tab, click the **Install Game** button.
3. Follow the directions until installation is complete.
4. Exit Windows and restart your computer.
5. Click on the Fury3 icon from Program Manager and enjoy!

Note ➡

Fury3 requires additional utilities (win32s, wing, dispdib.dll) to run under Windows 3.1. If you do not have these already installed, you will be prompted to install each one during the Fury3 Trial Version installation.

Problems Viewing the Demos

Note ➡

You can exit a demo at any time by pressing the ESC key on the keyboard.

Many of the product demos on the CD Sampler require Video for Windows or the Windows Media Player to run in their entirety on systems running Windows 3.1 or Windows for Workgroups 3.1. If you encounter an error while running a demo which informs you that Video for Windows is required, you can install the necessary software directly from the CD Sampler. If you need to install the Windows Media Player (Video for Windows) on your machine, select the following topic:

Installing Windows Media Player (Video for Windows)

By using Windows Media Player, you can play multimedia files, such as sound or animation, and control hardware devices, such as a videodisc player. You must have Windows Media Player installed on your computer to run several of the product demos on the CD Sampler.

To install Windows Media Player:

1. Quit the CD Sampler.
2. Click on the letter for your CD-ROM drive in **Explorer** or **File Manager**.
3. Click on the folder **VFW11.WIN**.
4. Double click on **Setup.Exe**.
5. Follow the on-screen instructions until Setup is complete. You may need to reboot your system for the new system files to load.
