This is the tool box of objects you can select from, After you define your topics you can specify the topic names to jump to for the jump labels and images. You also can attach notes to topics for future reference. An outline view of all topics is available to view the structure of the help file and it is also used to access the topics for editing. You can develop windows help documents using Visual Help and the Help Compiler only, you do not need any word processing application to accomplish this task.

Visual Development environment

Develop your help files in a visual environment that relates to your work style, Visual Help will simulate your help file in a runtime environment that looks exactly like the end product before compiling. This will allow you to test and prototype your project without the wait.



The above picture is a SHG file, this allows you to specify multiple hot spots within a bitmap, using visual help, all you have to do is use the shed editor to create the image and then drag and drop the shed object in your topic, yes it is that easy.

Control over Details

Visual Help allows you to control the attributes of your help file in details, with control over all the project options supported by the Help Compiler, and the definition of styles for text objects.

Programmer Support Features

Visual help allows the programmer to define context lds manually or automatically to save time. Also you can export all defines to include files to be used with C, Pascal, or Basic projects. This is just a few of the features that make Visual Help and ideal development tool for help files,

Visual Help also assigns Browse sequences for you automatically every time you build your help file, how about that for automation.

Visual help provides you with detailed reports about all topics in your project, you can have an alphabetical list of your topics or even and outline of the topic hierarchy.

Create the manual for your program from the help file, Visual Help's export Wizard will create an RTF manual with all style definitions.
