

# Metro 'LaserTwin for Windows' Install Help

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## **Automatic Setup**

If you select Automatic setup, the installation program will automatically make all the changes to your win.ini file needed to add the LaserTwin for Windows printer driver under either Windows 3.0 or Windows 3.1. If you don't select automatic setup, the installation program will not make these changes, leaving you to do them using the Windows Control Panel. Automatic mode is recommended unless you have some other version of Windows besides 3.0 or 3.1.

## **Select the Drive**

This Dialog shows you a list of available hard drives, and the amount of free space on each. Use the up and down arrow keys, or your mouse to select the drive you want to install LaserTwin for Windows onto. Note that some files will be installed in your Windows System directory.

## **Select directory**

This Dialog lets you enter a directory name for LaserTwin for Windows. The default is 'lt5win'. If this default is OK, just hit <Return>. If not, type in the name you want to use, and then hit return.

## **Printer Selection**

This Dialog lets you select the printer you will be using. Use the arrow keys or the mouse to select the printer you will be using. Then hit Return or click on the 'Continue' button.

## **Port Selection**

This Dialog lets you select the Port you have your printer connected to. Use the arrow keys or the mouse to select the port you have your printer connected to. See your Windows User's manual for more information if you are not sure of what the port names mean.

## **Default Printer?**

This Dialog asks you if you want the install program to set the LaserTwin for Windows printer as the default printer. If you answer 'No', you can always do this later using the Windows Control Panel.

## **Installation Completed**

This lets you view the Read-me file or make the test printout. When you are finished, click on the 'Done' button to exit the Installation program.
