

## AdWiper Help

AdWiper is a plug in for Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 (or higher.) AdWiper examines web pages as they are loaded by Internet Explorer and will remove many of the common web advertisements. AdWiper will **not** remove every advertisement from every web page; but it is able to find and remove quite a few.

## AdWiper Configuration

You can control several things about how AdWiper will block ads from your computer, and other text it will add to pages that it has modified.

To get to these options, run the "AdWiper Configuration" item in the "AdWiper" group under your Start button->Programs menu.

You must [register](#) AdWiper for the **Insert note that page was modified** and **Insert statistics about ads removed** items to be enabled.

- **Block image advertisements:** Blocks many advertising banner and button images. You probably want to leave this always turned on unless you are having trouble viewing a site (can happen if their regular images are sized like banners.)
- **Block Java advertisements:** Blocks many advertising banners and buttons that use Java to show advertisements. You probably want to leave this always turned on unless you are having trouble viewing a site (can happen if their regular Java applets are sized like banners.)
- **Finding ads to be removed:** AdWiper calculates how likely each image or Java applet is to be an advertisement. This tells AdWiper whether to be more or less tolerant about removing items. For example:
  - Normal:** Being the size of a banner (468x60) is enough to remove a link.
  - Find More:** Being close to the size of a banner (468x60 ± 3) is enough to remove a link.
  - Find Less:** Being the size of a banner (468x60) is not enough to remove a link. The link must also contain the word "Banner" or "Ad" or something extra to be removed.
- **Insert note that page was modified:** A small line of text is added at the bottom of each web page where AdWiper has removed ads to say that the page was modified.
  - ⇒ You must [register](#) to be able to use this option to turn off the text. ⇐
- **Insert statistics about ads removed:** A line of text is added at the bottom of each web page where AdWiper has removed ads to say that the number of ads removed from that page and the total number of ads removed.
  - ⇒ You must [register](#) to be able to use this option to turn off the text. ⇐
- **Insert HTML to replace each ad:** You can use a custom bit of HTML code to replace each ad so you can tell where the ads were removed. In the listbox below this checkbox, you may type in any HTML fragment to be used, or select one of the pre-defined ones.

There are several variables that will be replaced with values from the removed ad (these variables are case sensitive, and must be in UPPERCASE). All of these *except* TEXT and DIR also include the XXX= part of the HTML (so if you include %HEIGHT% it will be replaced by something like HEIGHT=60) If the removed HTML did not contain the value--such as not having an ID value--the %XXX% for that variable will be removed from the result.:

%HEIGHT%	Height of image/appet removed.
%WIDTH%	Width of image/applet removed.
%HREF%	Address of web page where the ad goes.
%TEXT%	Text extracted from the ad. (From ALT of image, regular text, server name, etc.)
%DIR%	Directory where AdWiper is installed. (Does NOT contain ending \ on the path)
%ALIGN%	Alignment property of image.
%HSPACE%	Horizontal space property of the image/applet.
%VSPACE%	Vertical space property of the image/applet.
%ID%	ID property of the image/applet.

**%CLASS%**            Class property of the image/applet.

Some examples you may use:

**{Ad: <A %HREF%>%TEXT%</A>}**

Creates a short text version of the ad. (This is the default.)

**<IMG SRC="%DIR%\transparent.gif" %HEIGHT% %WIDTH% %ALIGN% %HSPACE%  
%VSPACE%>**

Several images are included in the AdWiper directory for you to use.

**ADWIPER1.GIF** image that looks pretty good for replacing both banners and buttons.

**ANIMATED1.GIF** animated wiper from the "About AdWiper" window. (Looks pretty horrible at anything but a button size, but maybe someone will like it. Feel free to use it on your web site to let others know about AdWiper!)

**BANNER.GIF** is a banner sized image saying the ad was removed by AdWiper. Looks good replacing banners, but not buttons.

**BUTTON.GIF** is a button sized image saying the ad was removed by AdWiper. Looks good replacing buttons, but not as good for banners.

**TRANSPARENT.GIF** is a entirely transparent GIF so the background of the page will show through.

Pretty much the same as the earlier banner, except you can click on this one to go to the AdWiper home page.

### ----- TIPS -----

#### Redisplaying Ads.

- If you refresh the web page using the "Refresh" button in Internet Explorer, or go back to the web page using the "Back" button in Internet Explorer, the page will be displayed as it is stored on the web server. All ads and changes made by AdWiper will be removed. (This is because at this time, AdWiper does not change the copy of the web page that is stored in Internet Explorer's cache.)

### ----- FAQ -----

#### AdWiper used to work, but now it does not work at all.

- There are several possibilities:
  - 1) Another program may have set itself as the filter for web pages in Microsoft Internet Explorer. To fix this, run the [AdWiper Configuration](#) item in the AdWiper group under the Start menu.
  - 2) AdWiper may have been moved to a different directory. To fix this, you must run the AdWiper installation program again to properly install it in the new location.
  - 3) Web sites have changed how they display ads so AdWiper can't identify them. Try viewing the AdWiper test page at <http://www.adwiper.com/#test> to make sure it will block these ads.

#### I installed AdWiper, but it does not work.

- Make sure you have closed and restarted Microsoft Internet Explorer. If you have Microsoft Internet Explorer integrated with Windows95/NT, you will need to reboot before AdWiper will begin to work.
- AdWiper requires Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 or higher.

#### What about Netscape web browsers?

- I don't know if the same things are possible yet. If they are, a version of AdWiper for Netscape will be coming. (Once Netscape has released their source code, as they have announced that they will, something will definitely be possible.)

## Registering AdWiper

This program is released as [Shareware](#) and costs \$17.50 (US) to buy. You may use this program for 30 days free as a trial. After that time you are expected to either register this program, or remove it from your computer.

### What registering will get you:

- An [unlock code](#) will be emailed to you to tell AdWiper that you have registered.
- AdWiper will stop replacing some banners with reminders to register AdWiper.
- For the foreseeable future, and probably forever, **all upgrades to AdWiper will be free to registered users.**
- You will get emailed notices on upgrades to AdWiper.
- Enable the other items on the AdWiper [Setup](#) form.
- The more people who register this shareware, the more incentive to make AdWiper even better!
