Grids 4 Kids consists of 4 games built around a basic grid shape. The "old favorite" Tic, Tac, Toe, has been updated with the option of allowing the computer to make the first move. The Simon Says game is a variation on Jeff Elkins' Simon 1.01 game. Match Blox is a game that combines many of the features of the old TV show, Concentration, with the addition of randomly generated simple math problems as an extra challenge. Code Buster, combines a variety of basic math skills with a "not too" challenging phrase to decode.

Grids 4 Kids requires Microsoft Windows, 3.0 and has been tested with EGA and VGA displays.

As with all shareware, your support is a vital component of the future of this product. If you find any problems or would like to see new features and/or games added--let me know.

Some enhancements already planned include support for multiple players to play against each other, user-definable code-phrases for the Code Buster game, and a Hang-man type of game.
