

# ***Not Much Documentation for SIMPLFAX***

## **0. What is it?**

SIMPLFAX is an extremely simple sample program for sending short fax messages via Delrina's WinFax, targetted at Visual BASIC programmers who want to add such capabilities to their own programs. **SIMPLFAX is NOT a complete, Full Tilt Boogie application.**

To do anything useful with it, you'll need:

- \* Microsoft Visual BASIC v2.0 Standard Edition or better;
- \* Delrina WinFax PRO v3.0 or better (dunno if the 'Lite' and 'Ultralite' versions will work);
- \* Windows 3.1 or better with the TrueType fonts Arial and Times New Roman installed.

SIMPLFAX's source code will show you how to do the following things:

- \* Getting and/or setting the default Windows printer from within VB;
- \* Retrieving the current WinFax settings from WIN.INI
- \* Sending parameters to WinFax using DDE;
- \* Retrieving the path to WinFax and activating it if it's not already running.
- \* Writing the most terrible text formatting code ever seen.

## **1. What can I do with it? (In other words: the LICENSE AGREEMENT)**

You may freely use and distribute SIMPLFAX, its source code and documentation as long as:

- \* You use the abovementioned materials in a friendly and lawful way;
- \* You don't sell SIMPLFAX or use it as added value in a sales transaction;
- \* You don't distribute modified copies of SIMPLFAX in any way.

You can freely distribute modified versions of SIMPLFAX as long as:

- \* You include a copy of the original SIMPLFAX source code and documentation with your modifications.

You can freely distribute your own programs using ideas or code from SIMPLFAX as long as:

- \* Your product adds significant functionality to the original SIMPLFAX.

There is no license fee for SIMPLFAX. If it is useful in any way to you, however, you're invited to send a nice postcard to the author (see section 2 for address details)

Warranty: If you break it, you own both parts. As this program is absolutely free, the author provides no warranty whatsoever about functionality, stability or usability.
