

Visual Basic Listbox Controls

This control provides three new controls to Visual Basic. To begin using the controls, copy **VBLISTBX.VBX** to your Visual Basic directory. Select "Add File..." from the "File" menu and select the file from the listbox displayed. If all goes well, you should see three new icons appear in the toolbox.

Properties:

CellWidth: For multicolumn listboxes only, this sets the width of each display cell in pixels.

List(index): Gets or sets data to a listbox cell.

ListCount: Returns the number of items in the listbox.

Select(index): Returns Zero if an item is not selected, 1 if it is selected.

Update: TRUE enables repainting the listbox, FALSE prevents repainting.

Version: Returns the version of this control. 100 is version 1.00, for example.

Events:

Clicked: Called when an item is clicked.

DbIClk: Called when an item is double-clicked.

Notes:

Select may be used to get the select state of an item or to set the select state. If an index of -1 is used to set the select state, the state passed is applied to all items in the listbox, providing a simple, fast way of selecting or unselecting all items in the listbox.
